

Dear Friends.

Hasn't it been wonderful to see more people back to worship in pew? It has been a difficult time of discerning what to do, when and how to do it, and implementation of changing policy. I know that many of you have been stressed out by it and have done your best to accommodate change in cherished habits. You are generous and kind and it is deeply appreciated. I want to thank my staff: Connie, Deacon Chuck, Bobby, and Karen for their patience and initiative in serving us through this last difficult year. We tend to take on your confusion, pain, stress, and hurts. For myself, I have taken them to prayer so many times. And I also recommend cat videos on Facebook, lots of cat videos for stress relief!

I want to update you on the Annual Diocesan Appeal 2021. Like everything last year, it reflects the challenges of the Covid pandemic and guite possibly, our parish family's economic circumstances. In 2019 St. Therese had 231 of 654 families participate and in 2021 169 families participated. In 2019, St. John had 13 of 44 families participate and in 2021, 14. In 2019 and 2020, both parishes had more money eventually donated than was pledged!

Both the parish and the diocese have seen less inpew donations because of Covid. For instance, the donation of cash (not Checks, envelopes, or on-line giving), termed plate, is down almost 80% at St. Therese. The online giving increased to help cover. In the diocese the donations and pledges have dropped also because of a decrease of major donors and the environment surrounding the presidential elections.

Next week the members of the Finance Council will give you an update on our parish finances and we will follow with the in-pew pledge. I hope for the increase in participation of our families in the life of our diocese and I am aware that this past year has decreased the fortunes of some and increased the blessings of others. May we all be content and joyful in our gift.

= Notes from our Boy Scout Troop 7 =

Senior Patrol Leader: Shawn Hardy, Cobras patrol Scout Law: A Scout is Trustworthy, Loyal, Helpful, Friendly, Courteous, Kind, Obedient, Cheerful, Thrifty, Brave, Clean, and Reverent.

- ~ April: Custer Campout: 11 Scouts and 3 adults camped 2 nights in Custer State Park, earned 6 frost points and hiked 6.8 miles along the Lover's Leap and Prairie Trails. ~ City-Wide Cleanup, April 24. Scouts will focus on removing trash and debris along Mount Rushmore Road as part of the 50th Annual City Wide Clean-up. ~ 50-miler backpacking meetings begin to support planning and preparations for a backpacking trip in the Black Hills and Wind Cave National Park. The 50-miler is a 7-day, 6-night camping trip in which scouts will hike over 50-miles of trails, carrying everything they need on their back. This is a "High-Adventure" trip, and only scouts age 14 and above can participate, due to the nature and black of Commission of the National Park.
- ~ May: Spring Camporee, April 30-May 2. Camping at the Mt. Rushmore KOA, scouts will focus on the Mining in Society Merit Badge and visit the Big Thunder Gold Mine. Busy Beaver, May 14-16. Scouts from Troop 7 will assist the Black Hills Area Council in preparing Medicine Mountain Scout Ranch for the arrival of Scouts from across the nation at Summer Camp.
- ~ June: Flag Retirement, June 7th. Under 4 USC, Chapter 1, §176, (k) the flag, when it is in such condition that it is no longer a fitting emblem for display, should be destroyed in a dignified way, preferably by burning. Members of Troop 7 will retire U.S. Flags which have been collected via the "Retiring Old Glory" drop box here at St. Therese.
