
# **Church of Saint Therese**

Dear Friends.

I rarely have an opportunity to do the Sacrament of Confirmation, usually at Easter if there is a baptism or if I have delegation to confirm a baptized but non catechized adult. I can also confirm anyone who may be in danger of death. This weekend, on Saturday evening, I was able to confirm our young people. They are about a year older than I was when I was confirmed, but I don't remember much about their age.

In fact, I heard it said by a presenter to the priests at Clergy Days once, that we have never been their age. The presenter made the point that our youth, thirty to fifty years ago, bear little resemblance to the world our kids live in today. I must say I agree. What is available to children via the web and mobile phone is vastly more plentiful and sometimes dangerous (information) than anything to which I was exposed. We have much more competition for the mind and heart of our children and our church members than ever before.

With that in mind, I am deeply gratified that these kids who are confirmed have chosen to be church goers and their families have facilitated their attendance. We look forward to what they will offer, and how they will lead the young people in youth group and parish activities. I ask our parents to help them continue in faith formation through the youth group and by your practice at home.
