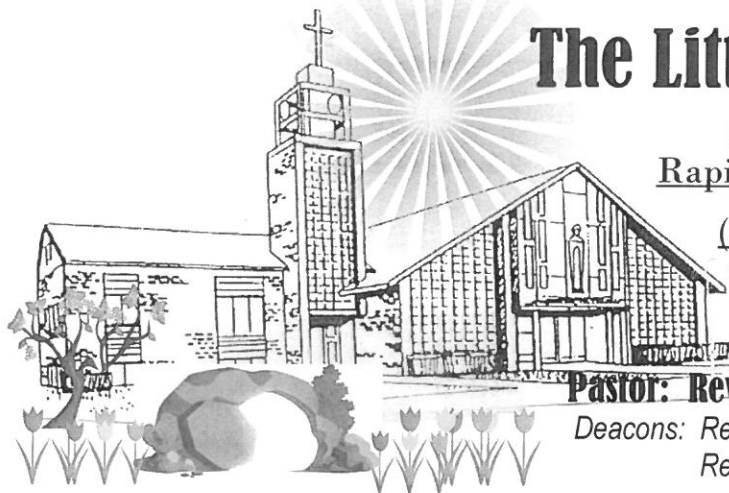

== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

"REJOICE AND BE GLAD" (Mt 5:12), Jesus tells those persecuted or humiliated for his sake. The Lord asks everything of us, and in return he offers us true life, the happiness for which we were created. He wants us to be saints and not to settle for a bland and mediocre existence. The call to holiness is present in various ways from the very first pages of the Bible. We see it expressed in the Lord's words to Abraham: "Walk before me, and be blameless" (Gen 17:1).

These words open the Apostolic Exhortation of Pope Francis given from Rome last week to the whole world. Francis wants us all to be saints. That is the essence of our Christian vocation. We have a universal call to holiness in our baptism that sets us in motion, in service to the world. We are leaven and salt. The leaven calls forth growth and the multiplication of graces, while salt gives flavor, excitement, and energy to our capacity to love. Pope Francis' encouragement is a reflection on the beatitudes.

He especially asks us to reflect on how the Beatitude, blessed are the merciful, was brought out in the preaching of Jesus, Matthew 25, "I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, I was naked and you clothed me, I was sick and you took care of me, I was in prison and you visited me" (vv. 35-36). Francis reminds us that St. John Paul II said: "If we truly start out anew from the contemplation of Christ, we must learn to see him especially in the faces of those with whom he himself wished to be identified". In other words, if we want holiness, our prayers will lead us to Christ in the faces of the hungry, thirsty, naked, etc.

While I am laid up, I will read the whole of this document. I urge you to read it also. I think it would make for an interesting study topic. Happy Easter! I will let you know how I am doing next week.

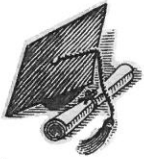

April is National Child Abuse Prevention Month

Did you know: There are behavioral warning signs of child abusers?

Training and education help adults recognize grooming techniques that are precursors to abuse. Some abusers isolate a potential victim by giving him or her undue attention or lavish gifts. Another common grooming technique is to allow young people to participate in activities which their parents or guardians would not approve, such as watching pornography, drinking alcohol, using drugs, and excessive touching, which includes wrestling and tickling. It is also critical to be wary of age-inappropriate relationships, seen, for example, in the adult who is more comfortable with children than fellow adults.
