Divine Mercy Sunday

Wow! It has been an extraordinary two years at this parish now. Man, time flies, doesn't it? Jesus has given many graces to my family and me. Most important is the mercy he has provided during our difficult times from the headaches and frustration of moving here to Rapid City in a week! Jesus called us to come here even though I was stressed at the world, because like all, we hate moving - right? We liked life the way it was. Or at least I did. My wife (Grandma) didn't mind moving at all. I wanted to wait another year. Most important, we are now closer to family and the grandchildren, with great joy! This reminds me of how merciful and understanding He truly is, even when we vent at Him at times. He just waited until I blew off steam and then poured His all merciful love in my heart to remove the stress; to see the true purpose of His divine plan for me and my family; to be more merciful when things get tough in life, with others too, to confide in Jesus, in everything we do. What a perfect time to discuss this during Divine Mercy Sunday.

So, what is this Divine Mercy Sunday? I had a general familiarization of what this great day is all about, but really never looked into it further, until diaconal formation. Here is a brief history. There were series of revelations to St. Maria Faustina Kowalska in the 1930s, our Lord called for a special feast day to be celebrated on the Sunday after Easter. Today, we know that feast as Divine Mercy Sunday, names by Pope St. John Paul II at the canonization of St. Faustina on April 30, 2000. Jesus didn't say to St. Faustina, "If you want to." He said, "Make it know." Out of love and faith for Jesus, St. Faustina made it happen.

After reflecting on the message Jesus provided to Sister Faustina and the whole world, I can see three important messages.

Always seek and ask for His mercy. God always wants us to communicate in prayer on a continuous basis every day, to repent our failings every day, and call upon him to pour out His mercy and of the whole world.

Always be merciful. Especially to others. Everyday God is saturating His love and mercy within our hearts, so we in turn extend this love and forgiveness to others through ourselves, as He loves and forgives each and every one of us.

Always and completely trust in Jesus in everything, even if we do not agree. He knows the plan and us. God wants us to know that all the graces of His mercy can only be received in our trust. This is part of our Faith: to trust in the Lord. The more we open our heart and trust, the more grace and mercy we will receive.

A letter from the Bishop...

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Here in the United States there is a great need for evangelization and sharing the message of Christ and the beauty of the Church. The church at home needs to be strengthened and fortified. Soon, as a diocese, we

will take up the Catholic Home Missions Appeal (CHMA), which supports the neediest dioceses in the United States. This appeal makes the most basic faith programs possible and shares the Gospel message with our brothers and sisters in dioceses where Church communities scattered and struggling.

The Catholic Home Missions Appeal provides much-needed assistance for ministry in our diocese and in other rural, mission dioceses in our country. In 2022 we received \$45,000 from this collection to help with family life ministry, faith formation, ministry formation, communications and Native American ministry. These funds helped us to support our rural parishes with faith formation, to provide formation for deacons and lay ministers, to send the *West River Catholic* to each Catholic household in the Diocese, and to provide for the needs of pastoral teams in the most remote areas of our diocese. In addition, we received a donation of 12 Roman Missals valued at over \$2,000, and received word that we will be receiving a grant from Catholic Home Missions to help with the costs associated with the Eucharistic Revival in our diocese.

Other dioceses face similar challenges with many miles and fewer priests, just like we do. The Collection helps provide retreats, youth/campus ministry, service projects, RCIA classes, Bible studies, Hispanic ministry, sacramental preparation and Sunday Masses in parishes of mission dioceses across our nation.

Your support of this appeal makes a difference in the faith lives of our brothers and sisters right here in our own diocese and in other mission dioceses in the United States. Please prayerfully consider how you can support the appeal this year.

Thank you for strengthening the Church at home.
