Blessed Easter everyone!

As I write early last week, I am hoping for an Easter that is peaceful, fruitful, and joyous. Perhaps you have had the experience of loving the moves you made to change, end or begin habits, or moving to silence in your day to pray. If you have, know that the habit is just as special as we enter the Easter season. Several years ago, I made a determined effort to never shop on Sunday. I have mostly kept that habit intact. I have a habit of taking a siesta in the afternoon, to honor the day of rest, sabbath, and ready myself for the last Sunday evening Mass. Maybe what we give up next year will be something we give up forever.

Pope Francis this week called for an Easter peace as well, saying, "He can even bring an end to a war whose end is not in sight, a war that daily places before our eyes heinous massacres and atrocious cruelty committed against defenseless civilians. Let the weapons be put down! Let the Easter truce begin."

## A letter from the Bishop...

My Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Here in the United States there is a great need for evangelization and sharing the message of Christ and the beauty of the Church. The Church

at home needs to be strengthened and fortified. Soon, as a diocese, we will take up the Catholic Home Missions Appeal (CHMA), which supports the neediest dioceses in the United States. This appeal makes the most basic faith programs possible and shares the Gospel message with our brothers and sisters in dioceses where Church communities are scattered and struggling.

The Catholic Home Missions Appeal provides much-needed assistance for ministry in our diocese and in other rural, mission dioceses in our country. In 2021 we received \$40,000 from this collection to help with family life ministry, faith formation, ministry formation, communications and Native American Ministry. These funds helped us to support our rural parishes with faith formation, to provide formation for deacons and lay ministers, to send the *West River Catholic* to each Catholic household in the Diocese, and to provide for the needs of pastoral teams in the most remote areas of our diocese.

Other dioceses face similar challenges with many miles and fewer priests, just like we do. The Collection helps provide retreats, youth/campus ministry, service projects, RCIA classes, Bible studies and Sunday Masses in parishes of mission dioceses across our nation.

Your support of this appeal makes a difference in the faith lives of our brothers and sisters right here in our own diocese and in other mission dioceses in the United States. Please prayerfully consider how you can support the appeal this year.
