Dear Friends,

In daily Mass I have been praying for your needs, anticipating that you are growing tired of the demands of safety or the lack of interaction. I have also been praying that this time helps each us re-examine our normal. I have found that I enjoy the lovely home provided for me and the books I have bought and have not read. I am also beginning to appreciate calling people on the phone; never one of my favorite things. I also have tried in the last week to be more deliberate about a daily schedule. Today I am going to clean off my desk and order my office!

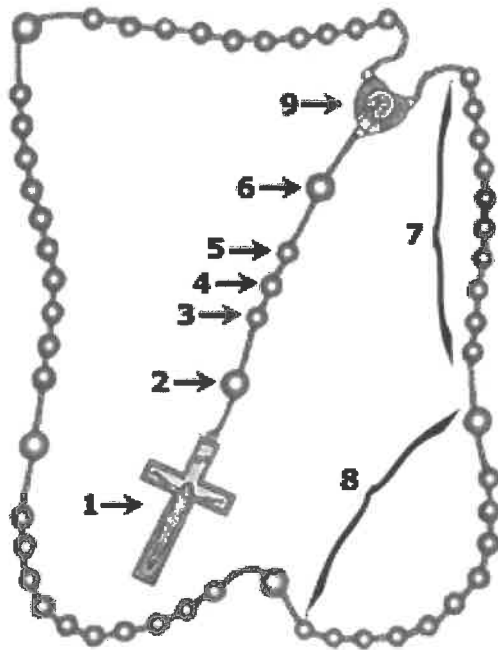
Prayer has led me to be particularly concerned for the needs of doctors, nurses, caregivers, companions to the elderly, and anyone who needs to protect their health because of the nature of their work. While I was praying yesterday, I looked up our Holy Father Francis' homily for Holy Saturday. I want to share this excerpt with you, reflecting on how they reacted to the death of Jesus.

*Yet in this situation the women did not allow themselves to be paralyzed. They did not give in to the gloom of sorrow and regret, they did not morosely close in on themselves, or flee from reality. They were doing something simple yet extraordinary: preparing at home the spices to anoint the body of Jesus. They did not stop loving; in the darkness of their hearts, they lit a flame of mercy. Our Lady spent that Saturday, the day that would be dedicated to her, in prayer and hope. She responded to sorrow with trust in the Lord. Unbeknownst to these women, they were making preparations in the darkness of that Sabbath, for "the dawn of the first day of the week", the day that would change history. Jesus, like a seed buried in the ground, was about to make new life blossom in the world; and these women, by prayer and love, were helping to make that hope flower. How many people, in these sad days, have done and are still doing what those women did, sowing seeds of hope! with small gestures of care, affection, and prayer.*

May your prayer and belief in the Risen Christ give you hope that never dies and courage that never fails.

You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty yourself out upon us.

O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the heart of Jesus as a fountain of mercy for us, I trust in you!

*Repeat three times*

## 3. Our Father

Our Father, Who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come; thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

## 4. Hail Mary

Hail Mary, full of grace. The Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

## 5. Apostles' Creed

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; he descended into hell; on the third day he rose again from the dead; he ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from thence he shall come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

## 6. Eternal Father

Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of your Dearly Beloved Son, our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

## 7. On the Ten Small Beads of Each Decade

For the sake of his sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

## 8. Repeat for the Remaining Decades

*Say the "Eternal Father" on the "Our Father" bead and then ten "For the sake of his sorrowful Passion" on the following "Hail Mary" beads.*

## 9. Holy God

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

*Repeat three times*

## 10. Optional Closing Prayer

Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to your holy will, which is love and mercy itself.

As fear grips our country, let us choose love. During this time when we cannot physically wrap our arms around each other, let us yet find ways to be the loving embrace of God to our neighbors. ## **Hope For New Life (HFNL) Ministry**

**Advocating Against Despair** To be isolated and cut off from family and loved ones is surely the most difficult and trying condition anyone can face. Feelings of isolation and despair are therefore very real to the inmates of Pennington County Jail. Consider this recent prayer from a male inmate from one of our recent Wednesday groups: "Dear Heavenly Father, I pray for my wife and I pray for my kids... that [we] will be together again. Lord, please help me with my troubles and my sorrows. I shed tears for [my family] every day. Fix my life. Teach me your ways, Father. Amen." It is precisely in such a seemingly hopeless situation that Our Lord can reach out through His Holy Spirit, providing salvation, love and hope to those who would otherwise despair. Jesus assures us of the gift of the Holy Spirit, the Advocate and Spirit of Truth: "He lives with you and will be in you. I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you....Because I live, you also will live...you are in me and I am in you (John 14: 17-20)." HFNL was established for the express purpose of bringing Our Lord's Good News to our imprisoned brothers and sisters. During each of our weekly jail visits, our message to the men and women is always one of Hope: The Lord will guide us in our deepest struggles, forgive our sins, hear our prayers, and shoulder the burdens we cannot bear. *If you would like to learn more about our ministry, please contact Bill Gradoville 605 430-2697.
