Dear Friends in Mission,

I want to give you an update on the Catholic Build for Habitat for Humanity that is in process at 726 E Madison. You should really drive by and see the work that is already done. Both duplexes are framed and ready for further work. The first two townhomes facing Spruce Street have families selected who will be doing their education in budgeting, financial management, home repair and maintenance. They are ready then to begin their sweat equity hours working on these homes or another project around town. Due to great weather and exceptional volunteers the work is ahead of schedule. **If you would like to volunteer for a workday, please call Victor Walz at 308-379-9113.**

Our fundraising goal for the first build period ending last March was \$150,000. The entire deanery has raised \$128,000 so far. The fast pace of the building has outstripped funding, so we will be concentrating on finishing the first two townhomes with the families selected before we continue with the second pair of townhomes. So far St. Therese has raised over \$9100 of our goal of \$70,000 in the next two years. We have also donated 347 volunteer hours with 10 volunteers. I know more people have wanted to volunteer but did not have the phone number above.

We hope to do a citywide event soon to highlight the work we have done and celebrate our accomplishments. I am excited what this project will do to increase the livability and pride in our North Rapid community. I hope you will join me in praying for the success of this project. Unless the Lord builds the house, in vain do the builders labor. Ps 127.1

On this Good Shepherd Sunday we celebrate World Day of Prayer for Vocations. Pray for an increase in vocations to priesthood, diaconate, and religious life.

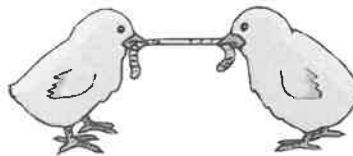

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Here in the United States there is a great need for evangelization and sharing the message of Christ and the beauty of the Church. The Church at home needs to be strengthened and fortified. Soon, as a diocese, we will take up the Catholic Home Missions Appeal (CHMA), which supports the neediest dioceses in the United States. This appeal makes the most basic faith programs possible and shares the Gospel message with our brothers and sisters in dioceses where Church communities are scattered and struggling.

The Diocese of Rapid City is classified as a mission diocese: a diocese with small or widely dispersed Catholic populations, large or rugged areas of land that make it difficult to minister to the needs of the people, or economic challenges caused by poverty, unemployment or natural disasters.

The Catholic Home Missions Appeal provides much-needed assistance for ministry in our diocese and in other rural, mission dioceses in our country. In 2024 we will receive \$54,000 from this collection to help with faith formation, communications, our safe environment program and Native American ministry. These funds help us to support our rural parishes, to send the *West River Catholic* to each Catholic household in the Diocese and provide information through other means to parishioners, and to provide for the needs of pastoral teams in the most remote areas of our diocese.

The Collection helps provide retreats, youth/campus ministry, service projects, RCIA classes, Bible studies, Hispanic ministry, sacramental preparation, criminal justice ministry and Sunday Masses in mission dioceses across our nation.

Your support of this appeal makes a difference in the faith lives of our brothers and sisters right here in our own diocese and in other mission dioceses in the United States. Please prayerfully consider how you can support the appeal this year.
