== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

"...conduct yourselves with reverence during the time of your sojourning, realizing that you were ransomed from your futile conduct, handed on by your ancestors, not with perishable things like silver or gold but with the precious blood of Christ. . ." 1 Peter 1.17

Dear Friends,

This time of our sojourning, Easter season, springtime, beckons us to observe and partake of new life, regeneration, the graces from our Risen Lord, and living the witness we are indeed changed by Christ for the glory of God. When this witness takes shape, we may reach others by the strength of our certainty. Witness means we will be given what to say in difficult circumstances. It means we may make resolution to respond actively to a grace given, or a prompting received in prayer.

Reverence is prayer. It is also a stance of receptivity, a way to be aware of the workings of the Holy Spirit. In a sacred space, we give the gift of silence, attentiveness, and awareness that sacred thoughts may be received, imagined, or brought to life by the Holy Spirit. When we enter a Church to pray, we enter with expectation that God is present and surrounding us with love and mercy. When we give other people present the gift of our silence, we acknowledge that God will be present to us and in us. We too, then, are sacred to the Lord.

I encourage you to come to the Church and make a visit to the Blessed Sacrament and experience the power of silence in prayer. If you go to St. John's and are the only one who doesn't know how to get into Church, ask another parishioner! St. Therese Church has to lock frequently when staff are not present because of the neighborhood, but there will still be many chances from 6:30 am to @ 4 pm.

I also would like to invite you again to take part in the perpetual adoration that is held at the Cathedral. I go every Thursday at 3 am for my Holy Hour. Would you consider taking an hour during the week. I am the only one in my hour so if you were to sign up for that hour you would almost always have a substitute in place! 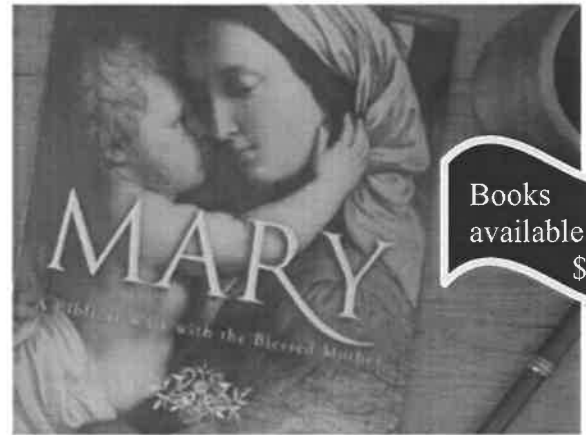
