== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Then beginning with Moses and all the prophets, he interpreted to them what referred to him in all the Scriptures.

As they approached the village to which they were going, he gave the impression that he was going on farther.

But they urged him, "Stay with us, for it is nearly evening and the day is almost over." So he went in to stay with them.

And it happened that, while he was with them at table, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them.

With that their eyes were opened, and they recognized him, but he vanished from their sight. Then they said to each other,

"Were not our hearts burning within us while he spoke to us on the way and opened the Scriptures to us?" Luke 24.27-32

I love the story above of the disciples leaving Jerusalem, downcast because of the death of Jesus. Luke, the evangelist, remembers in detail like an observant physician, the way Jesus began to walk with them in their sorrow and accompany them in their grief. In only a short time they had completely changed in their demeanor because of a new understanding. Christ was with them still! They recognized him in the breaking of the bread (Eucharist).

A Christian is a witness to the fact that Christ had Risen. Even the first disciples only saw an empty tomb, but their faith was rewarded by an experience of the Risen Christ. These disciples responded to the revelation of the old prophets, and to what they had seen and heard. If Christ is risen, we have nothing to fear. We must share the Good News. Everyone wants good news, and the world sorely needs it.

We know that God can bring good even out of the greatest evils, just as he brought salvation and the Resurrection out of the horrible failure of the Crucifixion. As a result, we have strength to weather any storm that comes our way. We don't have to understand why God permits certain hardships and sufferings, because we already know that in the end he will never let us down. Pray with this gospel: read, sit in silence, reread it quietly aloud, listen. I think you will come to the deeper conviction that we never walk alone, and in Jesus each of us has a worthy and eternal destination worth any sacrifice.

Eucharistic Adoration

Before moving on to speak about the Concluding Rites of the Mass, it is important to pause and reflect on Eucharistic Adoration. Jesus continues to be present with us in the Eucharistic Species. The Blood of Christ is consumed at the end of Communion. The Body of Christ is reserved in the tabernacle. In addition, we have times of Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament when the Eucharist is displayed in the monstrance to allow us to adore the Lord who remains present with us in this unique manner. As Catholics we have the privilege of visiting the Church, praying before the Blessed Sacrament, either in the tabernacle or exposed in the monstrance. This prayer before the Lord present in the Blessed Sacrament is a continuation of our Communion with Him.
