WHAT IS REALLY HAPPENING TO CHRISTIANS IN NIGERIA?

Consider this link <https://www.dailywire.com/news/new-report-estimates-that-over-8000-nigerian-christians-killed-kidnapped-last-year>.

When politics are in bed with religion, it breeds tension, misunderstanding and ultimately bloodshed. Nigeria has her own share of this interplay. As a multi-ethnic and religious country, the interplay of ethnic politics and multi-religious struggle for domination are really visible. The Muslims systematically have eliminated Christians from political offices, hence they dominate the government.

Two major religions are dominantly visible: Christianity and Islam. Christians appeal to people's conscience to convert to Christianity while Islam forces people to convert. It is this political and religious battle that defines the constant unrest and killings.

Boko Haram, like the Taliban, are the world's third-acknowledged terrorist group. This army drives the Islamic jihad and are quietly supported and encouraged by the political elites in the Nigerian government. This means the Nigerian government is run by the terrorist group Boko Haram. They engage in forceful conversion to Islam, ethnic cleansing, and demographic reengineering. The poor people, the indigenous groups, and the Christians then become victims of their massacre/bloodbath.

We have to ask ourselves, "How much do I know about world jihad? What is actually happening in Nigeria: a neo Christian persecution or ethnic cleansing/genocide? Why is all the main world media quiet and silent?"

What can we do?

- 1) Educate yourself and others on Muslim/Christian relationship.
- 2) Talk to the media, political leaders and your religious leaders regarding the persecution and genocide of Christians throughout the world (even in your own country).
- 3) Pray. We must pray for Christians worldwide, particularly in Nigeria.

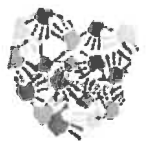

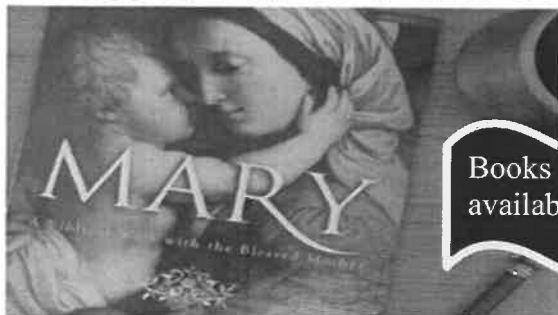
