Dear Families of St. John's and St. Therese,

When we began our Lent this year, none of us could have predicted that we would be a church in isolation physically, but not spiritually. We are a community of believers learning how to love with social distance while protecting ourselves and our most vulnerable from viral danger. During this time it is important for you to know that the prayer of the Church is continuing with the daily offering of Mass, and the daily Liturgy of the Hours prayed by me and many others who have learned how to follow the Morning and Evening Prayer of the Church. I know many of you are out delivering meals, checking on neighbors, helping with shopping, and doing window visits with the shut-ins and residents of nursing homes.

In our daily prayer in Mass I am praying for all of you who have lost hours or jobs. These are difficult times and we hope to get through them together. Our St. John's family is still going forward with our Social Hall, but it will require thought and planning to do so prudently. The churches, as your homes and apartments, must keep the lights on and adjust what we do in our mission. People have been asking me how they may make their donation going forward. I can offer two ways: mail your envelope or check to the above addresses for your respective church, or go to our webpage [www.sainttheresechurch.org](http://www.sainttheresechurch.org) and use the donate button. When you click on that button there will pop up choices for St. John's General Fund, St. John's Building Fund, St. Therese General fund, other St. Therese Funds along with occasional funds for collections from the American Bishops.

We will try to help during these trying times, cooperating with agencies in the area, to meet essential needs. Through St. Therese there is an opportunity to help through Families in Need. I also ask that you remember a donation during Lent to Catholic Relief Services which is our national organization helping in emergencies and disasters throughout the world.

At St. Therese we are still open for private prayer at times throughout the day, answering phones, and attending to parish business. I ask if you drop in to see the ladies in the office that you talk to them from the doorway. If you have not already, I encourage you to share with us your email address and "friend" me and "follow" the St. Therese Church page on Facebook to get news, live streams, announcements, and articles that will help us keep connected and growing in faith.

Palm Sunday, April 5, you will have an opportunity to drive thru the St. Therese Parking lot for a blessing and pick up a blessed palm from 9 to 9:45 am and drive thru the St. John's in New Underwood Parking lot from 10:30 to 11:15 am. Please enter the alley at St. Therese from Van Buren Street by the big garage and exit on Adams Street. Watch for volunteers directing traffic. St. John's attendees enter from Main St. and exit to the highway.

This Holy Week we will live-stream services on Facebook beginning with Holy Thursday and Good Friday at 7 p.m., and Holy Saturday at 8 p.m. We will have Easter Sunday Mass at 9 a.m. Be sure to "follow" St. Therese Church on Facebook. **Local TV Mass** From Fr. ## Mental Health Wellness Tips for Quarantine

1. STICK TO A ROUTINE (including regular prayer time of 15 minutes + at a time).
2. Dress for the social life you want, not the one you have.
3. Get out at least once a day, for at least 30 minutes
4. Find time to move each day for at least 30 minutes
5. Reach out to others at least once daily for 30 minutes
6. Stay hydrated and eat well
7. Develop a self-care toolkit (this looks different for everyone, but most involve something from 7 senses: touch, taste, sight, hearing, smell, movement and comforting pressure).
8. Spend extra time playing with children (even over the phone or video chat)
9. Give everyone the benefit of the doubt, and a wide berth
10. Everyone find their own retreat space
11. Expect behavioral issues in children and respond gently
12. Focus on safety and attachment
13. Lower expectations and practice radical self-acceptance
14. Limit social media and COVID conversation, especially around children
15. Notice the good in the world, the helpers
16. Help others
17. Find something you can control, and REALLY control it.
18. Find a long-term project to dive into.
19. Engage in repetitive movements and left-right movements.
20. Find an expressive art and go for it.
21. Find lightness and humor in each day!
22. Reach out for help—your team is there for you.
23. "Chunk" your quarantine, take it moment by moment.
24. Remind yourself daily that this is temporary
25. Find the lesson
