== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Parish Family,

A Flourishing Catholic family, and a flourishing parish is one that keeps its mind and heart open to fruitfulness and growth. Our Church is known to be One, Holy Catholic, and Apostolic. We are a church for everyone, with a message for every man and woman that they are loved by a personal God and, invited to be in the communion of the Church as God's sons and daughters.

We have a team of men and women of our parish who will be meeting soon, Monday, August 28 at 6 pm, to give you an overview of the Church, answer questions, and here about your faith Journey. Maybe you are being called by the Holy Spirit, led by God, and encouraged by others to explore the faith. How will they know unless we invite. Our charism of apostolicity gives us the gift and responsibility to share our faith with others. Would you invite a friend or a family to come to the OCIA Information night on Monday, August 28 at 6 pm?

Pope Francis said, reflecting on Matthew the tax collector, "Here is the message for us: we do not have to wait until we are perfect and have come a long way following Jesus to witness to him; no, our proclamation begins today, there where we live. And it does not begin by trying to convince others, but by witnessing every day to the beauty of the Love that has looked upon us and lifted us up." Francis also recalled a line from a homily given by Pope Benedict XVI at a meeting of Latin American and Caribbean bishops in Aparecida, Brazil, in 2007: "The Church does not engage in proselytism. Instead, she grows by 'attraction.'"

For us this simply means we don't bring Christ by pointing out the errors or foolishness of others, but we share our faith, and let our words and deeds where we live attract others to Christ. We invite, Christ will convince. Many of those who have come to the Church, when asked why they didn't come earlier, often say that they had never been invited. Let us be the inviters.
