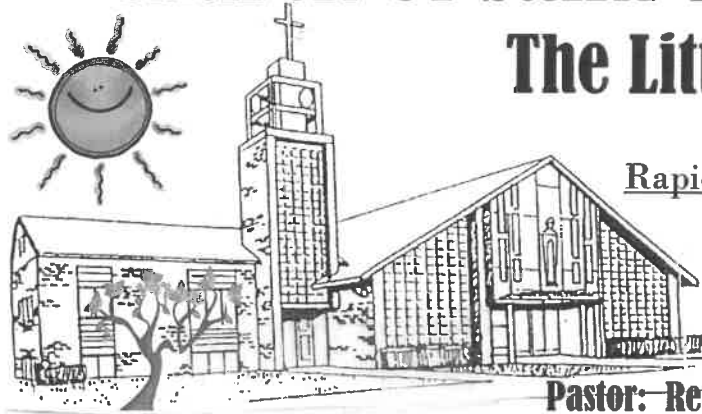

== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

*A great sign appeared in the sky,
a woman clothed with the sun,
with the moon under her feet,
and on her head a crown of twelve stars.*

Dear Friends,

Monday is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into Heaven. We will have the usual Mass schedule noted in the bulletin. I hope you can do something special that day with your family to honor her: a visit to the Blessed Sacrament chapel to say a prayer to Our Lady, Undoer of Knots, dessert with your evening meal, visit your loved one's graves, attend Mass together that day, anything you can imagine.

In the book of Revelation, the passage above tells us something very interesting about the way the early Church of the apostles viewed Mary as Mother of God. All the baptized and especially the martyrs are seen enjoying the peace and glory of heaven being whited robed and gathering about the throne of God. Mary, by contrast, is clothed with the sun! In the order of creation, she was born without sin; in the order of grace, she is the crown of all creation. While all creatures dwell on earth under the moon and stars, she has the moon under her feet and a crown, a diadem, of stars. Mary was beyond special to the early Christians.

In the prayer of the preface for the Assumption of the BVM, the church acknowledges by faith, that she, as mother of Jesus, Mother of God, did not undergo the corruption of the grave. Her death, her falling asleep, or dormition, as the Eastern Catholics call it, led to her being assumed into heaven in a grace as singular as her Immaculate Conception. This faith grew from the inspiration of the Holy Spirit in the life of the Church and was confirmed by Pope Pius XII in 1950.

Pope emeritus Benedict once wrote, "While she lived on this earth she could only be close to a few people. Being in God, who is close to us, actually, "within" all of us, Mary shares in this closeness of God. Being in God and with God, she is close to each one of us, knows our hearts, can hear our prayers, can help us with her motherly kindness and has been given to us, as the Lord said, precisely as a "mother" to whom we can turn at every moment."

Let us honor and share our life with our Mother Mary.

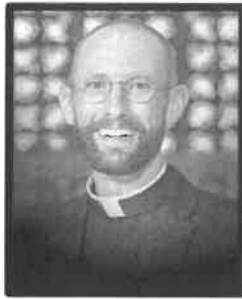

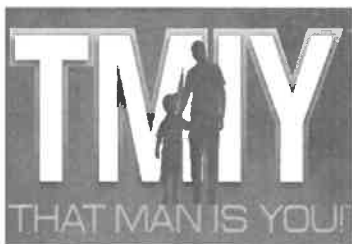
