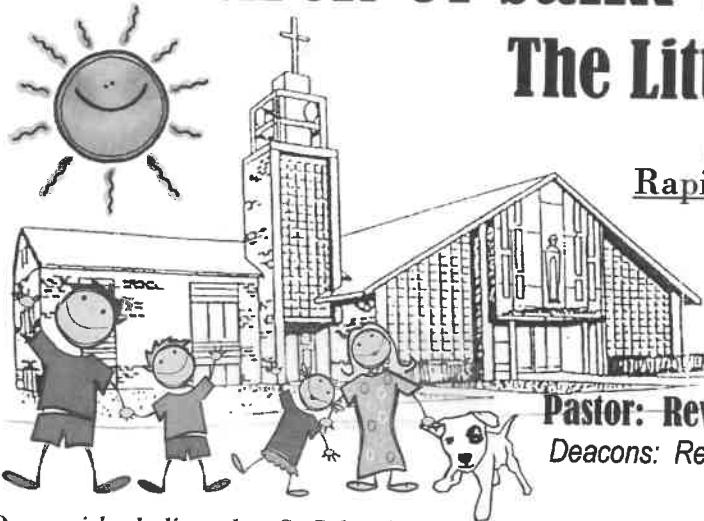

## == Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Parish Family,

I am in Washington this week for my nephew's wedding and to see our whole family in one place. After our family gathering in the Seattle area, I will drive down to Mt. St. Helen's to see the park and observe the way the area has come back since the eruption in May of 1980. I was graduating from college at North Dakota State that Spring and have always wanted to see the area of the blast. My brother who lived in Moscow, Idaho at the time scraped six inches of ash off his walks after the event. For something I have always wanted to see, 34 years is too long to wait. Clearly there has been some disorganization in my life. As a priest, and disciple of Jesus, we are meant to live intentionally in our thoughts, prayers and actions. As I write this on the Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary, I am reminded by the liturgy of God's intentionality in creating Mary to be the Mother of his Son, and her single-minded will to be the servant of God. Finding that same kind of intentional love is a goal for all of us.

Last month I started a practice that has helped me very much. **While I have always prayed, I recently made a commitment to take part in Perpetual Adoration at our mother church, the Cathedral. Parishes throughout the Hills and individuals from all over the diocese have committed themselves to a holy hour before the Blessed Sacrament in the Lady's Chapel.** I signed up for a 3 a.m. slot and found that is the fastest hour of my week. The deep silence is incredibly helpful to prayer. I usually talk to God and Mary for a time and then do the Office of Readings, or matins, traditionally done in the early hours of the day. I hope many of you will be moved to participate in our Friday morning Holy Hour at St. Therese and join in the whole church in Perpetual Adoration at Cathedral. ### Hope For New Life (HFNL) Ministry

#### Celebrating 12 Continuous Years of Jail Outreach

The Hope For New Life (HFNL) Jail Ministry was formed in December 2005 and we began visiting the Pennington County Jail 12 years ago in July 2006. From the day of our first jail visit, our mission remains the same: "As Catholics, we bring Jesus' love to those who are incarcerated." Since our visits to the inmates began, we have missed only one or two nights due to inclement weather. An approximate calculation of our weekly Wednesday evening visits to date results in well over 600 face-to-face visits with the inmates over the history of our ministry. We do not mean to boast; the work we do is the Lord's and comes about through the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. Our program has steadily evolved and grown over the years. We began with one weekly women's group. Soon we had two men's and two women's groups each Wednesday. In 2017 the jail authorities installed a closed circuit television system (CCTS) which we began using in June of that year. We continue to meet in person every Wednesday evening with a group of between 6 and 12 male inmates. Simultaneously, our HFNL presentation is transmitted via CCTS throughout the 11 cell blocks in the jail thus increasing our jail audience to over 500 inmates each week. What a blessing!
