Dear Friends,

It was so hot last week I wanted to stand in a stock dam! It was so hot last week I saw a cactus saying, "No mas! No mas!" It was so hot last week I moved my flowerpots in the shade, and they said, "where are the margaritas?" Well, it was hot, and I was wearing black, and we all made it. We fielded some donations of bottled water for the Hope Center, and it was duly appreciated. Thank you everyone who watched out for your neighbor in the extreme heat.

I want to address one change in the schedule coming up in August. August will see the cessation of the Noon mass on Friday. There are fewer attendees now that vaccine is widely received, and the ability to mask and socially distance at all the weekday masses is assured. In addition, we will continue to make sure we have seating and closed-circuit mass in the Hall downstairs. I will also have the hand sanitizer available for use after you have touched door handles, pews, bathroom visits and so on.

I want to also encourage everyone to have their Covid vaccinations if your doctor advises. A priest friend, who was fully vaccinated, recently had Covid and he experienced it like an inconvenient cold. The shots help ease the severity of the virus if you contract it. I will be getting the flu shot and the Covid shot, if necessary, in the future. I like to give myself the best chance with these preventative measures. A few years ago I got the flu anyway, but it was two days instead of five: good odds. As always, pray about it and use your best judgement.

Finally, I want to thank our two seminarians, Todd Vandermay and Jesse Willis for their time this summer. They are easy to be around and they are looking forward to another year of formation. Todd will be at Immaculate Heart of Mary seminary in Winona, and Jesse will be a Kenrick-Glennon in St. Louis. Their duties involved more residence here than while doing ministry for the diocese and Duc in Altum, but they will always be welcome back.

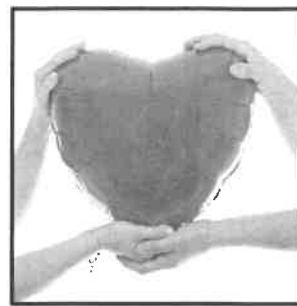
