Dear Friends,

Monday, August 29 at 6:30 pm, we will be hosting a come and see night for the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, RCIA, to give information about the program of formation and learning, and to give time for people to ask initial questions about the Church. The Psalm this Sunday proclaims, "Go out to all the world and tell the good news." What will our response be?

In our private prayer let us pray for zeal, a compelling virtue that comes from the heart of God who desires all souls be saved and none lost. If we have lost our zeal, if we are flat like a carbonated beverage abandoned on the kitchen counter, we can be made new, reborn in grace to have the virtue of desire for souls to come to the Lord. Will you allow discouragement about the way our church is viewed by the world keep you from being the joyful Christian that invites others to share our faith, or will you seek out the lost, the one on the sideline, the seeker who hasn't been asked? For some seeker, there will never be another you!

Luke evangelizes by weaving the theme of the banquet table in heaven throughout the gospel. We have the altar, the table of the Lord's real presence in our Churches. We are faithful to the revealed Son of God who gave his flesh for our food and his blood for our drink. Can we keep this to ourselves knowing that Jesus sees the nations coming to us for this universal gift of Christ to the Church?

In the closing chapters of Isaiah the prophet, God said, "I will set a sign among them; from them I will send fugitives to the nations . . . ". Think what happened when the Church was persecuted in 70 AD, and Christians had to flee the wrath of Rome, in Jerusalem and all the capitol cities. We fugitives, survivors, became a sign to the nations and people were soon coming from the East and West, the North and South, joining us in the Eucharist. Christ will use us to turn mourning into joy, draw life from death.

Let us pray, discern, invite!




