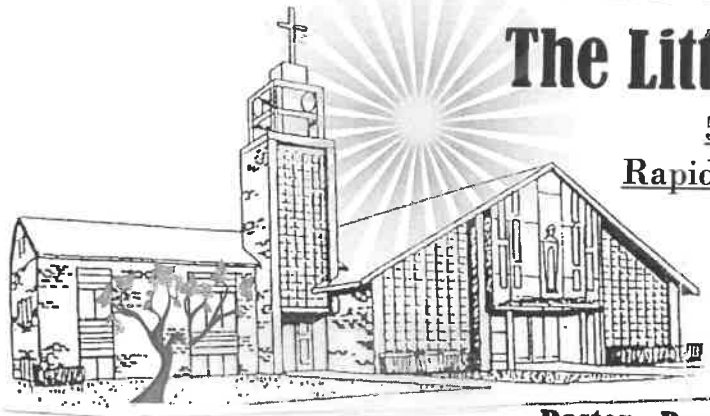

== *Fr. Kerry's Korner* ==

Among the Jesuits, there is a saying attributed to Pedro Arrupe, "Nothing is more practical than finding God, than falling in Love in a quite absolute, final way. What you are in love with, what seizes your imagination, will affect everything. It will decide what will get you out of bed in the morning, what you do with your evenings, how you spend your weekends, what you read, whom you know, what breaks your heart, and what amazes you with joy and gratitude. Fall in Love, stay in love, and it will decide everything." This is wise, practical wisdom, related to the Great Command, Love God, Love Neighbor.

One of the ways to nurture a sure, lasting love with the Lord, is through prayer. While praying is natural and everyone may pray, it is also good to look at prayer intently and ask Jesus, as many have before, teach me to pray.

This September, I am beginning a group for men who desire to pray and learn more about discernment called **Cor ad Cor**, heart to heart. It will involve a weekly meeting, about twenty sessions. We will study and pray together and learn from the wisdom of St. Ignatius of Loyola. If we have enough, we will have two small groups, keeping the total in a group to 12. **I may be able to start a group for women as well. Please email me or call the Office to sign up and we can determine a day and time later.**

We will learn about using our imagination and all our senses as we pray. We will be able to discuss blocks to prayer, dealing with distractions, and how to find the best way for each of us to pray.

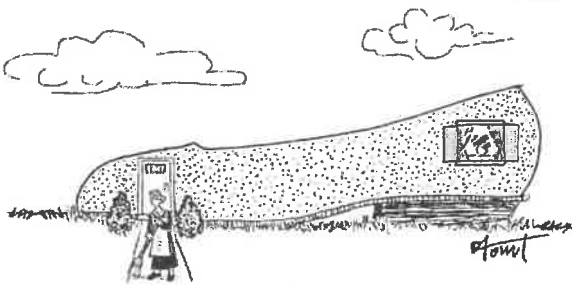
