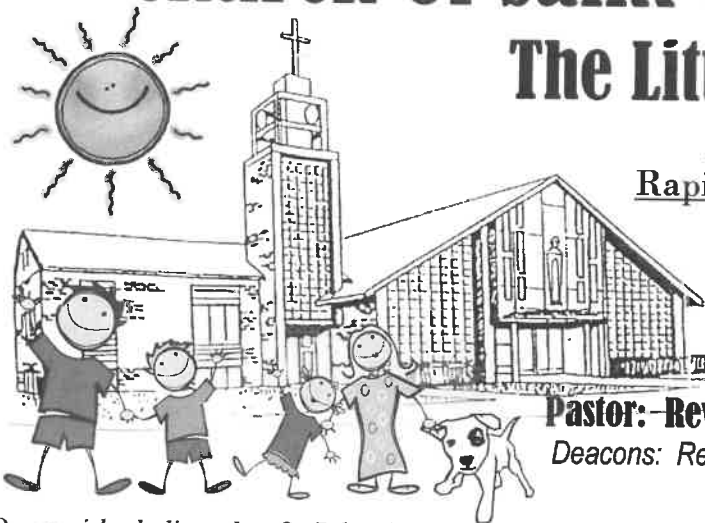

Our HFNL jail ministry currently consists of 7 Catholic men and women from all walks of life. Each Wednesday two of our members conduct a ministry outreach session for the inmates of Pennington County Jail. During our gatherings we read scripture, watch videos, share personal stories, sing, pray, and offer silence. Some of the subjects we have shared this year with the inmates are Forgiveness, Anger, Divine Mercy, Lives of the Saints, and DVD's including *The Passion of Christ*, *God Is Not Dead*, and *Heaven Is For Real*. Personal Bibles, rosaries, chaplets, and holy cards are given to all who desire them. While many of the inmates are imprisoned for only a short time, others are there for over a year. They have very divergent faith backgrounds. Each week they sign up to come and are very appreciative of our HFNL visits. We also take prayer requests from the men and women and share these with our prayer partners who now number over 50. Please include HFNL and the inmates to whom we minister in your prayer requests.
