## == Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Friends,

August is here. It is the month I had hoped we would have the crisis days of the novel coronavirus behind us. Yet today, Wednesday, the state has recorded the most, new cases in one day since I began tracking figures. We are discerning with the Parish Pastoral Council the approach we may take for doing religious formation. Different school districts will have varied approaches and we have yet to consult our parents or the teaching team. Pray for the discernment led by the Holy Spirit. A complicating factor is the moving target of containment of the virus and the massive gatherings going ahead this month: the Central States Fair and the Sturgis Rally & Races.

When the schools and seminaries were shut down last March, I gained a housemate, seminarian Josh Lee. I have to say it was a blessing to have another person to live with and work with during the early days of quarantine. He was joined by Josiah Hanson. They are a delight to live with, pray with and work with. I know they will be excellent men for the priesthood and I pray they persevere and continue to be called in their vocation.

Being in the very top tier of priests by age and seniority in the diocese, I have had one problem: keeping their names straight. I must settle upon The Young One (Josh) and The Little One (Josiah). The names represent their age only and help me when I am in a hurry. They have learned to respond to these names and to speak up and enunciate so everyone can hear them. I do not need hearing aids. Josh and Joe (Josiah also goes by Joe, see!) will formally end their stay with the parish this week. I may persuade them to stay on for a short while, but they will soon be going off to school.

Monday all the seminarians and many of the priests will gather at Angostura and Hot Springs for a day of fun at the lake and conversation and good food in the evening. It will also be our time to say good bye to Bishop-elect Michel Mulloy and pray for his new journey. Keep us all in prayer and pray for vocations!
