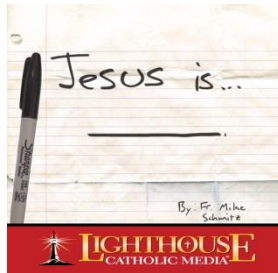

Veritatis Splendor Institute

This fall, the diocese will begin a new diocesan program of certification for catechists, the *Veritatis Splendor Institute* (VSI), named for Bl. Pope John Paul II's great encyclical, *The Splendor of Truth*. The goal of the VSI is the mission of the Church, that of proclaiming the Gospel to all people, and bringing people to a deeper encounter with Jesus Christ. This program will be an opportunity to grow as evangelists and teachers. The VSI will provide courses of instruction in the content of the Faith, catechetical methodology, classroom management, and courses for particular apostolates or ministries: youth ministry, RCIA, liturgy, music, retreats, adult education, children's catechesis, and more! The program will also offer formation in prayer, spirituality, and discipleship. The VSI will offer a Basic Level Certification (one-year program), and a Master Level Certification (two-year program, following after completion of Basic Certification), with courses offered once a month on Saturdays. An Update from Hope For New Life Jail Ministry

I Witnessed An Inmate's Baptism Is it reasonable to expect that after 8 years of volunteering with a Catholic jail ministry that I might have heard the same stories told by inmates time and again? Or that I might dismiss the lingering thought about some sort of unplanned encounter while I am visiting a group of men or women inmates? I tell you: it is miraculous how the Holy Spirit works there, making each encounter new and fresh. This was notably the case during a special jail visit on June 5th. That morning, I witnessed a lady who, after a lifetime of traveling a lonely world-focused path, chose a road of light and received the Sacrament of Baptism during a small mass held at the Pennington County Jail. Her name is Whisper; she's given us permission to share her story. The room that morning held Whisper, four other women inmates, Father David Matzko, Whisper's mentor who is a local Catholic man, and 3 women volunteers from Hope For New Life. It is rare for people to be at the County Jail for more than a few months, but Whisper's case has kept her there for over a year's time to hear Jesus knock at the door of her heart, seek out a way to complete RCIA, and to pray unceasingly for a way to get baptized. She is overjoyed at the thought of being part of God's own family. Was it coincidence that this particular Mass was the Celebration of Corpus Christi? Fr. Matzko's introductory comment was, "Today we celebrate a miracle-- the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, yet this gathering we have before us is no less extraordinary."
