If we had to list just ONE thing that makes the HFNL Jail Ministry a meaningful way to reach out to those in need, it would be that the inmates who attend our Wednesday evening programs want to be there. Certainly the path to follow Christ presents unique challenges if you find yourself "behind bars." Just what are these men and women hoping to hear? One message, in particular is sure to bring light to an inmates' eyes: Imagine for a moment that Jesus sits among us in our Wednesday evening circle with these men and women. He says, "Let me show you how important each soul is to Me. Think of Me in My humanity-I know firsthand the pull of temptation, suffering, and anguish. Now let's say that Satan offered Me every soul on earth, but one. I could escape the cross by stepping away from saving this one soul-even though this one might reject Me and be lost anyway. Would I be tempted? Consider that this one soul was yours. What do you think I would say? I assure you, I said NO. My suffering was for YOU." Isn't it interesting, this is the same message you and I yearn to hear: each individual soul is important to Our Lord.
