## == Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Parish Family,

I want to highlight some things the Diocese of Rapid City does that bear fruit for all of us. June 29<sup>th</sup>, the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul, the diocese ordained seven deacons. There are six permanent deacons, and one transitional deacon, Robert Kinyon. We expect he will be ordained priest next year. The diocese, through seminary education, the VSI program of catechist formation, and Deacon formation program, prepared these men for years of service. All of us working together, supporting the Bishop's Annual appeal, contributed to the investment in the mission of the Church. What a beautiful evening of ordination to celebrate.

This past July a granddaughter of Clint and Sandi Jolley made her final profession of vows with the Nashville Dominicans, a teaching order. While Sr. Lucia Christi was discerning her call to consecrated life, she spent several summers serving in the Duc in Altum summer program for youth. The seminarians and other young men and women are prepared and supported by the diocese for several weeks of training before they go out for the summer. Several men and women who have served on team have gone on to religious vocations as priests and religious sisters.

Now in August, the seminarians are going back to school. The diocese supports the collegians with financial help after they pay for what it costs to go to a state university in South Dakota. When the men in their last four years of preparation begin school the Diocese pays their way. We assist the diocese with seminarian education through our Adopt-a-Seminarian program. In addition, the parish of St. Therese will be sending a monthly stipend to our newest seminarian, Treyton Bushong from Faith, to help him with books, travel, and incidental expenses. Treyton was in Fr. Josh Lee's last confirmation class in Faith before he left for the Seminary! He spent some time after graduation in 2020 as a mailman and is now in formation at Immaculate Heart of Mary Seminary in Winona, Minnesota.

Be sure to share this news when people ask how we benefit from our gifts to the Diocese of Rapid City.

This is God's work through my hands. I have been blessed to be able to do this work, and each day I look forward to meeting another family to serve through the St. Vincent de Paul Society. 


