We also gathered all the priests and seminarians at Angostura on Wednesday to pray together and recreate at the lake. Remember Jesus, especially after big events, would go with his apostles or alone, to an out of the way place for prayer and rest.

Have you been observing the Lord's Day rest, or choosing another day for Sabbath rest? God gave us a command to rest for our benefit. He knows we need it. May I recommend also a mini-break in your day? Try taking time during the day to make a visit to the Church, to pray before the Blessed Sacrament. Maybe if you are retired or your work schedule permits you could attend daily Mass or spend time in the evening without music or cable. "I will come to you in the silence; I will lift you from all your fear."

A Note from Father Arnie Karl...

"Dear People of St. Therese & St. John, First and foremost, I want to 'thank you' for your prayers and wonderful support and friendship since I came to the parish last year. My last trip to L.A., they discovered the disease had moved into my ear canals. I had surgery-they drained the fluid behind the inner ear and put tubes in my ear drums hoping it would relieve the pressure and would give my ears a place to drain in to the sinus cavity. Unfortunately, it did not help. Tests have been done, which leads them to believe it has moved into my Ocular (eyes) system. This week I am to get my 3rd new pair of glasses, as my eyes have changed and NONE of the 3 pair are correct for my eyes to focus with. They are going to continue to pursue with testing where the disease is located. Hopefully we will have more options after further testing. Again, I thank you for your prayers, kindness and support in the days ahead. Fr. Prendiville and staff have been very understanding and very kind to me. I am grateful to them. 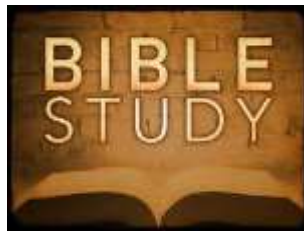
