== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Friends,

The prophet Isaiah recalls the mediocre King Ahaz of Israel being asked to ask for a sign, a great sign. Ahaz' sin and his general infidelity to the law of God, left him without discernment or will to ask for a sign, a reminder of hope. Hope is what he had long forgotten in favor of comfort, accommodation to the world around him, and peace with the nations about him. Isaiah cries out, "Is it not enough to weary my people, must you also weary my God?" For his lack of faith, Isaiah's God is not the God of Ahaz. He lacks faithfulness, discipline, or obedience to God's messenger (thus God).

Sin and the sadness of sin is a heavy weight to carry around. Think of how light you feel after you summon the courage to have that difficult conversation or that first step toward changing a habit. So is the soul lightened by the confession of our sins. How do we experience this lightness? Think of the increased energy for doing what is necessary, the clarity of mind a result of reordered priorities, the confidence of knowing that you are doing God's will, and the joy of being in right relationship with God, your family, and the poor.

Almsgiving, prayer, and penance point us to the light of Christ. The personal encounter with Jesus in the sacrament of penance brings the gift of peace, a response to the Baptist cry, "Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths." Tuesday evening, December 20, from 5-7 pm St. Therese will host a mercy night for the City. Please make plans to attend with your children. We will have confession aids available for any who need some assistance or confidence, and many priests to assist.

May Christ the light attract us to the renewal of our minds and hearts in Him.

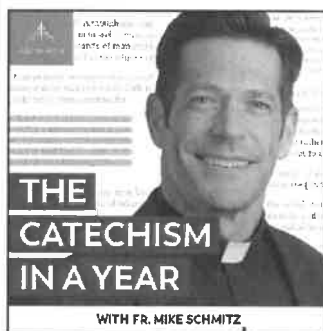

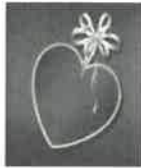

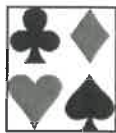
