Dear Parishioners and friends,

This third Sunday of Advent, we Gaudete (rejoice!) because we are over halfway through our Advent journey. Closer to that time when Jesus, the real gift of Christmas, comes to enlighten the world. The gift-bearer, Jesus tells us, "Give and gifts will be given to you; a good measure, packed together, shaken down, and overflowing, will be poured into your lap. For the measure with which you measure will in return be measured out to you." (Lk 6:38) Almsgiving and giving of gifts is one of the singular joys of the season.

We give alms (charitable giving to the poor and/or ministries that help the poor) because giving to the poor helps us to be true to our royal bloodlines. We are sons and daughters of God, who is endlessly generous and as the scripture says "lifts up the poor." (1 Sam 2:8) While we're at it, here's one more: "Whoever cares for the poor lends to the Lord, who will pay back the sum in full." (Proverbs 19:17)

I want to thank you for all the ways you are responding to the poor in our community and the seasonal requests that we are sponsoring to extend charity and Christmas joy for the poor, homebound, or elderly. I also want to remind you, if you have not already participated, to respond to the Annual Diocesan Appeal by giving a gift or a pledge.

Rejoice! We're a week out from Christmas and no matter how your advent journey has gone, it's not too late to prepare the inn (our hearts!) for the Lord. Let's spend this week praying more, doing some fasting and some good for the poor. Rejoice and prepare the Inn, Jesus is coming anew to me and you!

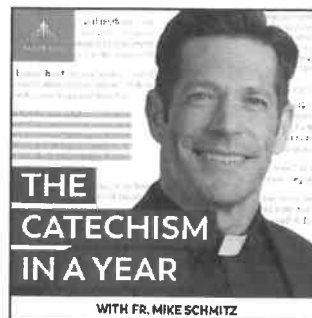

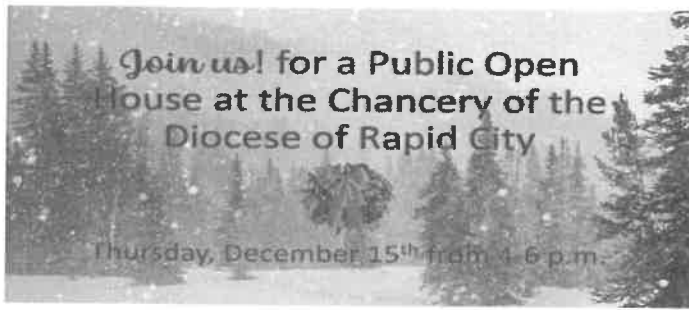
