Blessed Advent everyone!

The Advent season is rich with the memory of Mary, Mother of the Lord, and Immaculate Virgin. Last week we celebrated our nation's patron, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, remembering how this highly favored daughter of Israel was born without original sin to give to her Son, Jesus, a humanity perfect and unblemished. Today, Sunday is the Memorial of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of the Americas. If you have never been to the Hispanic Mass Celebration, 1:30 pm today at Blessed Sacrament, you owe it to yourself to attend. It is a beautiful, cultural and spiritual celebration.

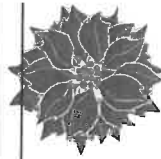
Praying with Mary, holding the mystery of Jesus in our heart, as Mary, is a reflective way of waiting for Christmas. In the silence of prayer, we may tune out the artificial busyness of the season and reject the projections of the world on our Holy Day, the Incarnation of the Lord. You who have the habit of the daily Rosary may already enjoy the fruit of discernment and wisdom in how you choose to observe Advent.

Dorothy Day, now deceased, is being considered for Sainthood and her cause will be submitted to Rome this week out of New York. Reflecting on her conversion to the Catholic faith, she witnessed the importance of Mother Mary: "God was our Father, so I could approach Him, daring to say, Our Father. But it was reading of Jesus Christ in the New Testament that made me want to put off the old man and put on Christ, as St. Paul said. And who had given me our Lord but the Virgin Mary? It was easy to pray to her, repetitious though it might seem. Saying the Rosary as I did so often, I felt that I was praying with the people of God, who held on to the physical act of the Rosary as to a lifeline, a very present help in time of trouble. Franz Werfel said of an old woman that she told her beads as though she were knitting garments for the poor."

I encourage you to pray with Mary, attend daily Mass throughout the city when possible, and take in an evening for the **Sacrament of Reconciliation**. We will have our service this Thursday, the 16th at 6:30 p.m.

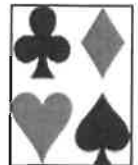
