== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

*He said: I am the voice of one crying out in the desert,
'make straight the way of the Lord,' "*
as Isaiah the prophet said. "

Dear Friends,

How often are we asked the question, "Who are you?" The question is usually straightforward in social settings, meeting someone for the first time. John the Baptizer was asked in many ways, forcing him to answer first who he was not. "I am not the Messiah." "I am not Elijah". I am not who or what you expect. He answers by giving his role in this world, "I am the voice of one crying out in the desert. . . " He knew his name was John and he had to announce the coming of the Lord. He also knew that his life had prepared him to empty himself of his own desires and be the voice of radical repentance, turning to the Lord.

More frequently, the question, "Who are you?" may remain oblique, we approach it from less direct paths. The world is separated into two groups: those who signal their turn and those who do not signal where they are going - right or left. They find who they are after deciding or reflection upon their direction after they took the road less traveled. What we end up doing sometimes will tell us who we are. If we pay attention to what we do with our time, our leisure, within our family, in the community, we come to a greater understanding of ourselves. So, I must be the peacemaker. I am the creative one. I like to work behind the scenes and do what needs to be done. "I am a voice crying out..."

This Advent season, we have the mission to find our voice. We lift our voice or our talent to honor, announce, make known, serve, give glory to the One coming into the world: Messiah, Savior, Child. We make straight our way to the Lord. We remember who we are and whose name we bear. We clear out the cobwebs and move obstacles to the Lord.

Rejoice always. Pray without ceasing.

*In all circumstances give thanks,
for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus.*

Do not quench the Spirit.

Do not despise prophetic utterances.

Test everything; retain what is good.

Refrain from every kind of evil.

And rejoice friends, *Fr. Kerry Prendiville*

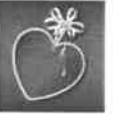

The Rules for the Discernment of Spirits

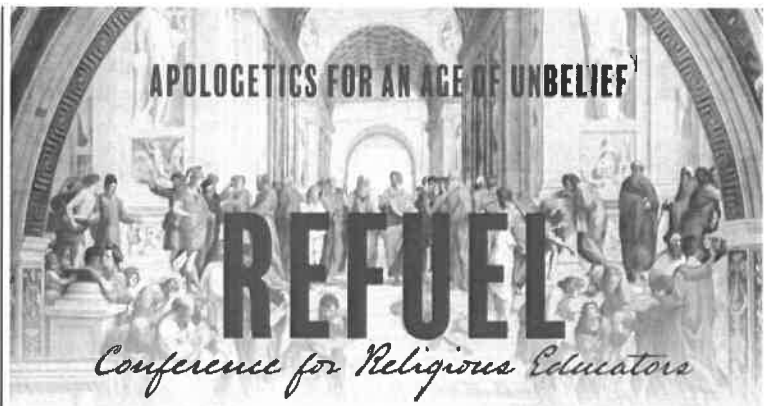
