As we draw Advent to a close with the Solemnity of the Nativity of the Lord, and the Feast of the Holy Family this weekend, I am thankful for the season of prayer and repentance that we are ending. 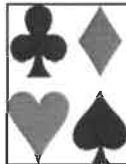

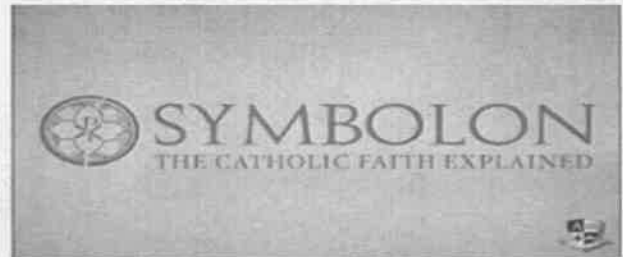
