== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Friends,

Merry Christmas! Have many blessings in this octave of Christmas, as we celebrate the Incarnation of the Christ child. I write this four days before Christmas with the weather app assuring me that warmth will be a gift that accompanies the Christmas solemnity. It was bitterly cold and windy, dangerously so, and we stayed indoors as much as possible. God bless those who plowed, patrolled roads, rescued the stranded, found the lost, and fed the animals.

My associate Fr. Francis has handled the cold like a native, but he sees the snow and cold and short days as only one who lived on the equator all his life will. I remember him recalling the darkness and the concept that some days have much less daylight. This natural process means that Christmas comes each year in the shortest days and the most darkness. The darkness of nature holds as much mystery and promise as light. The light of Bethlehem is a powerful reminder that all is being made new. We are made ready to receive the Lord. The Lord who comes brings us to our Father. *"This is the reason why the Word of God was made flesh, and the Son of God became Son of Man: so that we might enter communion with the Word of God, and by receiving adoption might become Sons of God. Indeed, we should not be able to share in immortality without a close union with the Immortal. How could we have united ourselves with immortality if immortality had not become what we are, in such a way that we should be absorbed by it, and thus we should be adopted as Sons of God?"* – Irenaeus of Lyons,

I hope you and your family will be renewed in the light of faith and desire communion with God and with one another. May you have an increase of faith, hope, and charity in the coming year, prosperity, patience, and all good things.

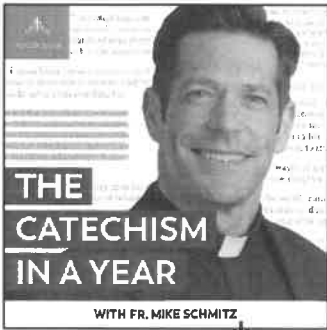

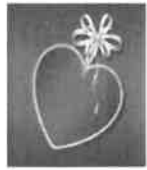
