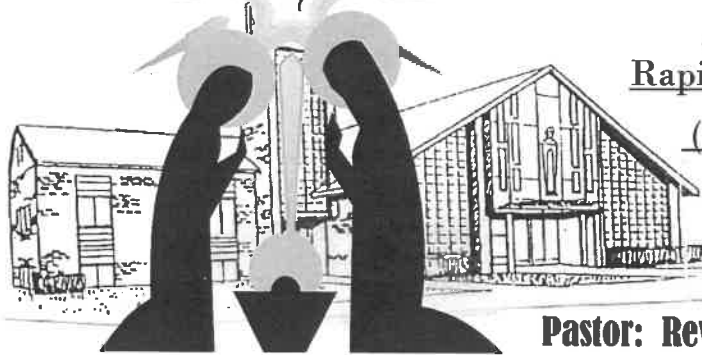

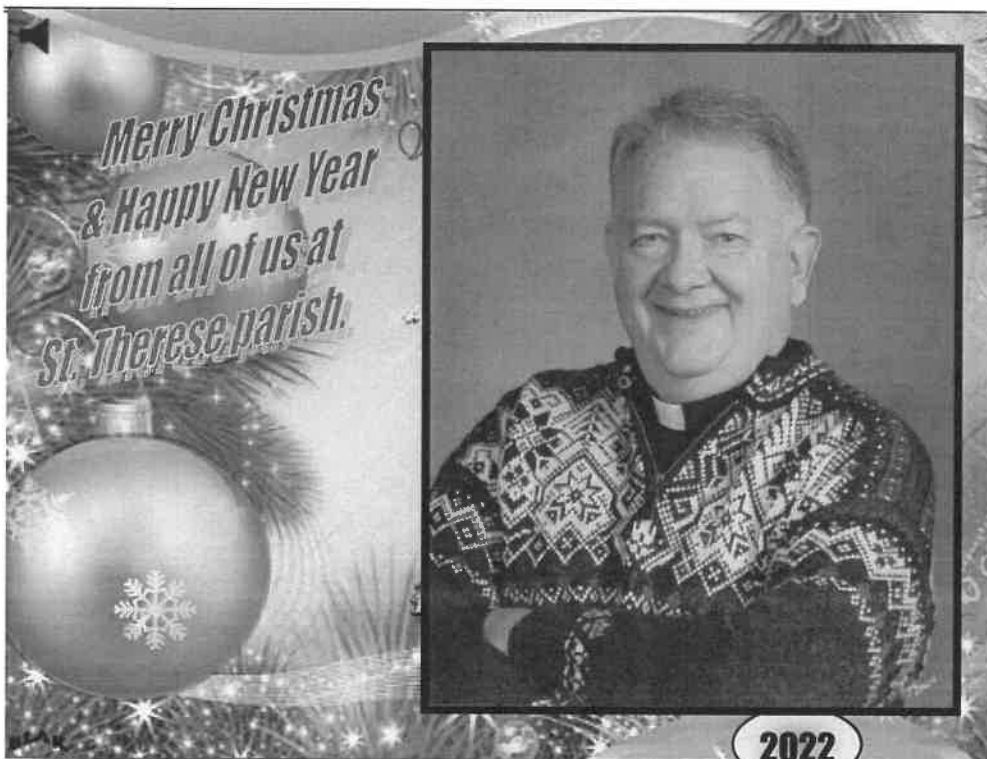

== *Fr. Kerry's Korner* ==

There is a short creation story found in some Native American communities that has implications for Christmas. The story is "Why Some Trees Are Evergreen."

When the plants and trees were first made, Grandfather gave a gift to each species. But first he set up a contest to determine which gift would be most useful to whom. "I want you to stay awake and keep watch over the earth for seven nights," he told them. The young trees and plants were so excited to be trusted with such an important job that the first night they did not find it difficult to stay awake. However, the second night was not so easy, and just before dawn a few fell asleep. On the third night the trees and plants whispered among themselves in the wind trying to keep from dropping off, but it was too much work for some of them.

By the time the seventh night came, the only trees and plants still awake were the cedar, the pine, the spruce, the fir. "What wonderful endurance you have," exclaimed Grandfather. "You shall be given the gift of remaining green forever. You will be the guardians of the forest. Even in the seeming dead of winter, your brother and sister creatures will find life protected in your branches." Ever since then all the other trees and plants lose their leaves and sleep all winter while the evergreens stay awake.

This story reminds us that remaining green in akin to "staying awake". This means remaining in the presence of a great mystery that God has given us all, creation, and we are part of it, watching over it, and anticipating the light and all things being made new. Just as the green tree in gray barren winter reminds us that life is not ended, so does the advancing light, leading to longer days, tell us that light dispels darkness and darkness cannot overcome it.

The green tree and the light of Christmas remains in all creatures, for they are guardians of all creation. These symbolize for us the Great Mystery of the Incarnation. Jesus born to us is Emmanuel, God-with-us. I pray for you all that the Light of Christ may dispel any darkness in your life, cast joy over any sorrow in your life, and renew your hope in the Father's benevolent love for you.

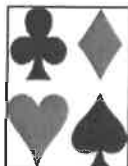

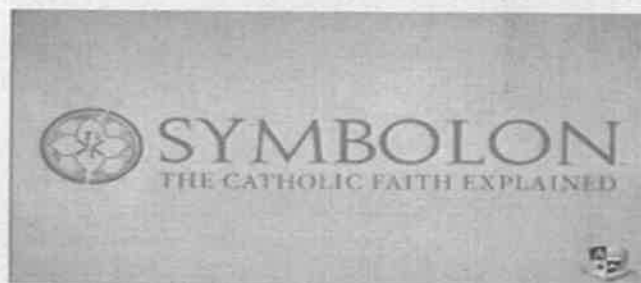

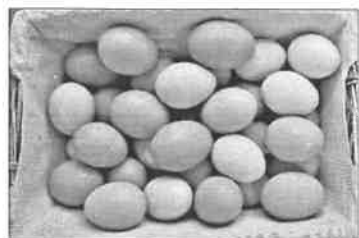
