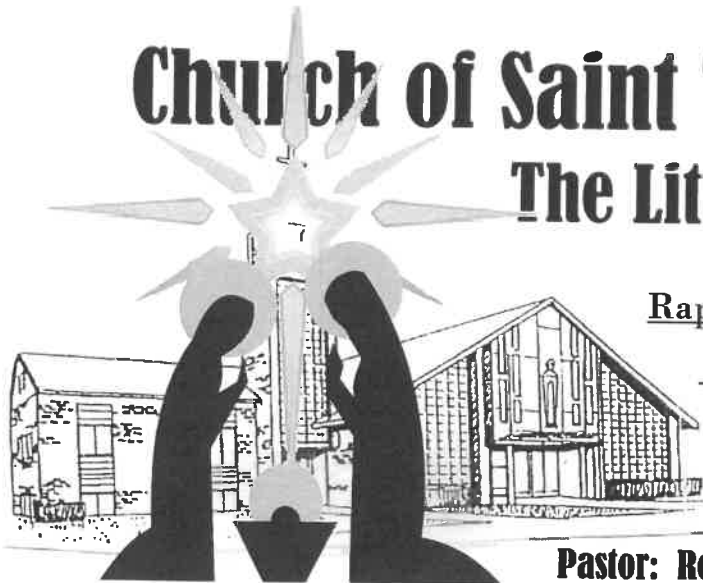

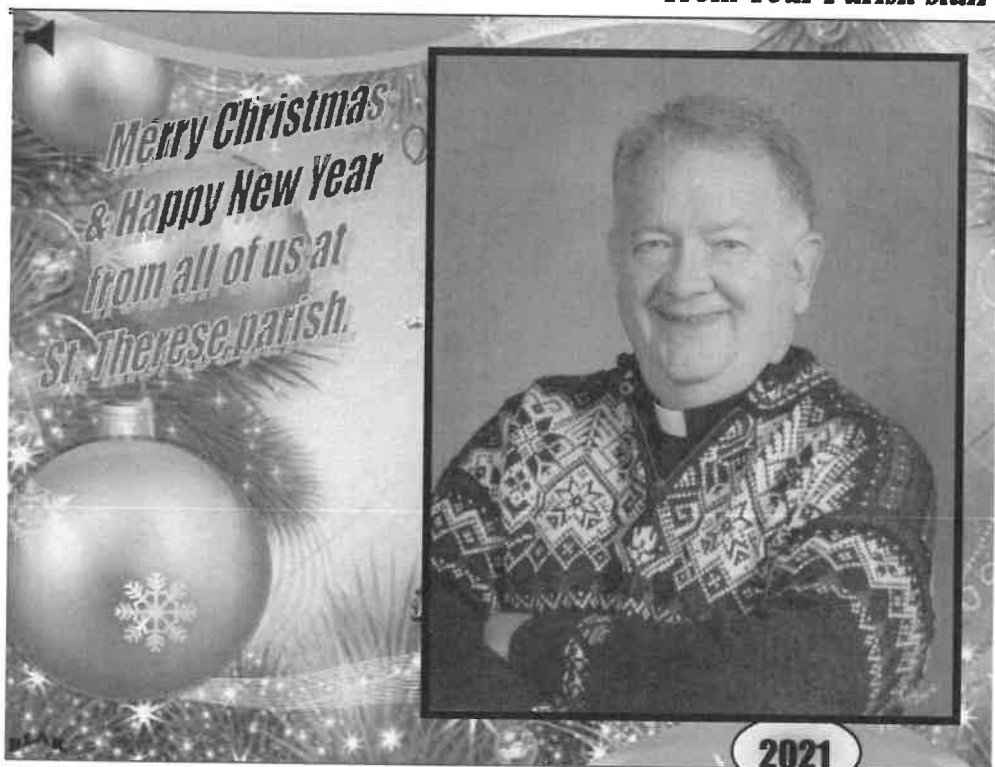

### Merry Christmas and Happy New Year everyone!

I hope your holy days are filled with blessed joy and fun with your family and friends. My family and I get together on video messenger or the phone and miles are wiped away. I know that the Lord of all life will draw you close to one another in ways the miles and quarantines cannot overcome.

When I was pastor of St. Ambrose in Deadwood I came across this thought from Ambrose who was the Bishop of Milan:

*“Let Mary’s soul be in each of you to proclaim the greatness of the Lord. Let her spirit be in each to rejoice in the Lord. Christ has only one mother in the flesh, but we all bring forth Christ in faith. Every soul receives the Word of God if only it keeps chaste, remaining pure and free from sin, its modesty undefiled. The soul that succeeds in this proclaims the greatness of the Lord, just as Mary’s soul magnified the Lord and her spirit rejoiced in God her Savior. The Lord is magnified, not because the human voice can add anything to God but because he is magnified within us. Christ is the image of God, and if the soul does what is right and holy, it magnifies that image of God, in whose likeness it was created and, in magnifying the image of God, the soul has a share in its greatness and is exalted.”*

As we progress through the Christmas season, we will celebrate on the 1<sup>st</sup> of January, the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God. We will certainly proclaim the greatness of the Lord with her. I hope you will keep the Christ in the center of your life as we observe the holy day of the Incarnation.

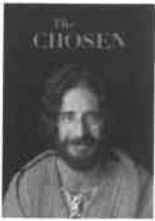

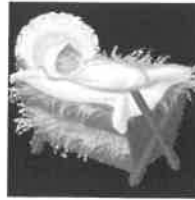

**= Notes from our Boy Scout Troop 7 =**

Senior Patrol Leader: Anthony Heard, Cobras patrol  
Scout Law: A Scout is Trustworthy, Loyal, Helpful, Friendly, Courteous, Kind,  
Obedient, Cheerful, Thrifty, Brave, Clean, and Reverent.

~ In November, six Scouts from Troop 7 took part in the "Introduction to  
Leadership for Troops" course (known as ILST), held at Medicine  
Mountain Scout Ranch. Scouts earned 39 frost points and completed  
2 nights of tent camping. All six Scouts are now eligible to attend an  
upcoming advanced leadership training course, "National Youth Leadership  
Training" or NYLT. When you see a Scout in uniform, they may be wearing a  
Trained Patch - if so, they have completed ILST. If you see a patch that says  
"NYLT" they have completed the NYLT course.

~ Also during November, Scouts from Troop 7 provided community  
support several times: ~ Scouts from Troop 7, Pack 7 and Pack 74  
supported their local community through the Scouting for Food  
collection. Troop 7, Pack 7 and Pack 74 covered Area 16, north of  
Lowes on Haines Avenue. Over 1,800 pounds of food were collected  
for the Feeding South Dakota food bank by Troop 7, Pack 7 and Pack  
74, and the Black Hills Area Council, in coordination with other local  
scouting Troops and Packs, collected over 27,000 pounds of food.

~ Scouts from Troop 7 also supported the Knights of Columbus and the  
local community during the annual Thanksgiving Food service.

~ In December, Scouts camped and hiked Bear Butte. Despite  
freezing temperatures and winds, Scouts completed 2 nights of tent  
camping, earned 33 frost points and hiked Bear Butte at 15°F with 30+  
mph winds. A frost point is earned for each degree below freezing, as  
measured during the night by an adult leader. No stoves or heaters are  
permitted in tents. Points are cumulative; if the first night is 22°F and second  
night is 12°F, a total of 30 Frost Points would be earned by each scout on the  
trip. Some Scouts in Troop 7 have in excess of 250 frost points, with many  
Scouts in the 100+ Frost Point range. Special awards are planned for  
milestones such as 100, 200 and 500 Frost Points during a Scouts tenure with  
the Black Hills Area Council.

~ Next week, Scouts will vote for a new Senior Patrol Leader - the  
Scout leader of the Troop. Terms of office are 6 months. Troop 7  
would like to recognize our outgoing SPL, Anthony Heard, for  
outstanding leadership in the past six-months!

~ The Scouts & Adults of Troop 7 would like to thank St Therese  
Catholic Church & it's parishioners for their continued support! Without  
the support of our Chartered Organization, Troop 7 wouldn't exist.

## Parishes Benefit from Your Charitable Contributions

The Diocese of Rapid City's Office of Development encourages your continued support through our Parish First Initiative, as your charitable gifts before December 31, 2020, are much appreciated! This past year has been challenging for everyone, we pray for more healing in 2021. Despite these uncertainties, we are humbled by your incredible acts of kindness, faith, and generosity in our parishes during these difficult times. Despite the untethered events of 2020, there are positive things to note. One is the tax benefits for donors created by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act). The legislation created donor-directed charitable giving deduction opportunities for church donations. Charitable gifts made to your parish made before December 31, 2020, can benefit from these tax deductions. We ask that you prayerfully consider contributing to your parish to help it thrive through these uncertain times.

**CARES ACT TAX BENEFITS OVERVIEW: Itemized Deductions** – the adjusted gross income (AGI) limit for cash contributions was increased for individual donors. For cash contributions made in 2020, you can now elect to deduct up to 100 percent of your AGI (increased from 60 percent). **Corporate Giving** – The AGI limit for cash contributions was also increased for corporate donors. Corporations can now deduct up to 25 percent of taxable income (increased from 10 percent). **Not Itemizing Deductions** – The CARES Act allows for an additional, "above-the-line" deduction for charitable gifts made in cash of up to \$300. If you are not itemizing on your 2020 taxes, you can claim this new deduction. We ask that you prayerfully consider how your charitable contributions helps your parish and always discuss your tax deduction strategies with your tax professional. We are grateful for your commitment to our Catholic faith and your willingness to help your parish in these uncertain times. **Please contact your parish and arrange with them how best to make your charitable gift before December 31<sup>st</sup>.** Thank you for your continued support that helps continue the mission of Christ here in the Catholic Church in western South Dakota. Merry Christmas to you and your family. God bless you, and thank you for your generosity!
