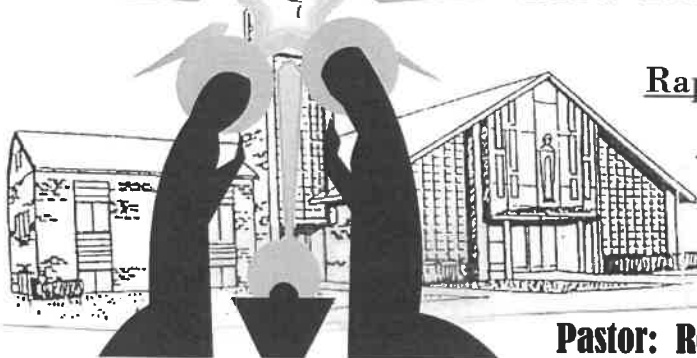

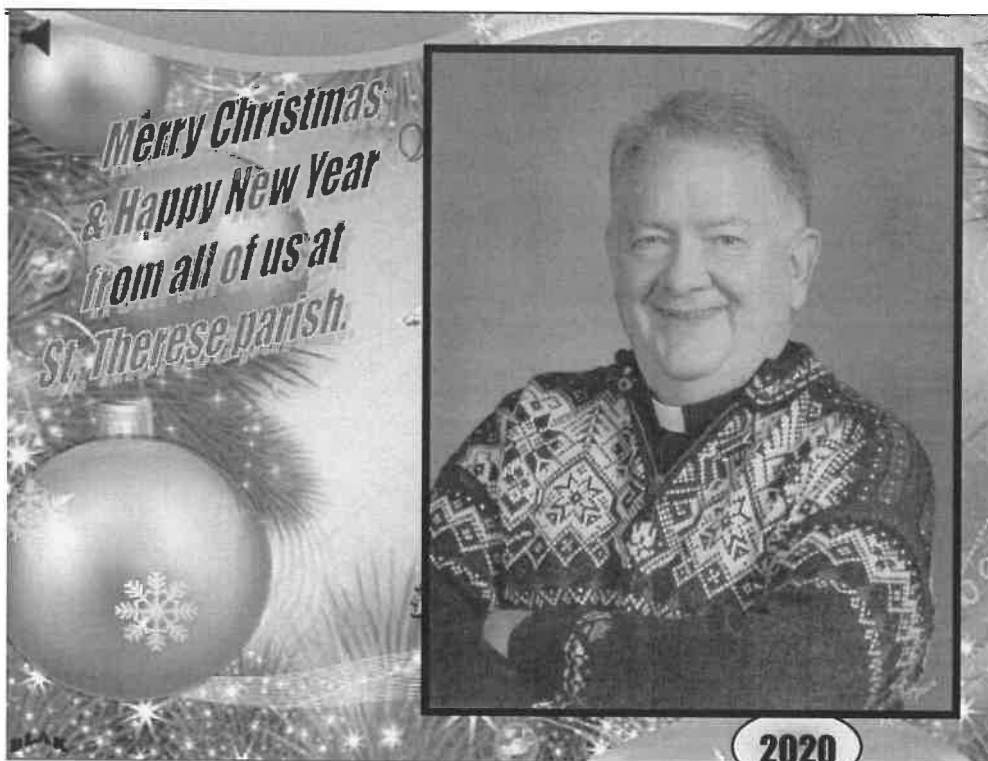

Faithful Citizenship "Wives, be subordinate to your husbands, as is proper in the Lord. Husbands, love your wives, and avoid any bitterness toward them. Children, obey your parents in everything, for this is pleasing to the Lord. Fathers, do not provoke your children, so they may not become discouraged." The Holy Family is the model of the basic unit of society. "How we organize our society—in economics and politics, in law and policy—directly affects human dignity and the capacity of individuals to grow in community. Marriage and the family are the central social institutions that must be supported and strengthened, not undermined." Parents who are respected and honored; children who are loved and cherished set the tone for a society of people who live in harmony. This is one of the Seven Pillars of Social Justice. Without an intact family structure, children are more likely to live in poverty, to be incarcerated, and to suffer many of the other social ills that Social Justice seeks to remedy. 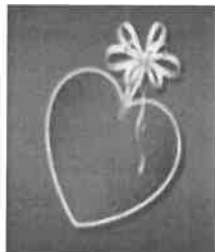

Correction to the West River Catholic

The December WRC carried an article on the beatification of Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen on page 9. The beatification has been postponed while officials review Archbishop Sheen's role in priest assignments in the Diocese of Rochester, NY. A press release from the Diocese of Peoria said, "In our current climate it is important for the faithful to know that there has never been, nor is there now, any allegation against (Archbishop) Sheen involving the abuse of a minor." Roe v. Wade Memorial Rapid City Right to Life will sponsor a memorial hour on Sunday, Jan. 19 at the Open Bible Church, 2225 E. St. Patrick, Rapid City. From 2-3 p.m. — prayer and guest speaker South Dakota Lt. Gov. Larry Rhoden. His topic is the sanctity of life. From 3-4 p.m. — reception. Catholics and Protestants are invited to join together on this important topic. The event is free, and no reservations are needed.



Blessing Prayers — These prayers formulated from similar prayers used in the second century are not heard if a song is sung. Being mindful that Jesus was Jewish, and he celebrated the Passover Meal, the Mass came from this experience at the Last Supper. These prayers that are used in the preparation of the gifts are very similar to the prayers used at the Passover Meal or the Seder meal. The priest who is Jesus present gives praise to God the Father for these gifts which come from human hands but will become truly divine in the Eucharistic sacrifice that will follow. If there is no singing, we respond with gratitude for God's goodness to us — "Blessed be God forever." All that we are, all that we have and all that we will become is because of the graciousness of our God. This expressed in these beautiful prayers or in a carefully chosen song.
