Faithful Citizenship Assisted Suicide and Euthanasia:

Beyond Terminal Illness Advocates for physician-assisted suicide and euthanasia often claim these practices will only affect a narrow class of terminally ill patients who are expected to die soon in any case. But there is ample evidence of a "slippery slope" toward ending the lives of patients with chronic illnesses or disabilities, or even those who are vulnerable or marginalized in other ways.

Swiss Group Will Euthanize Those Who 'Feel Old'

"In Switzerland, the association Exit (which has 70,000 members and is one of the biggest euthanasia organizations in the world) has voted to include 'suicide because of old age' on its statute.... Swiss law allows organizations that provide euthanasia services to establish their own internal rules, which may vary from clinic to clinic. The decision of Exit's board has been criticized by the Swiss medical association, which fears that such a move could encourage suicide among the elderly."
