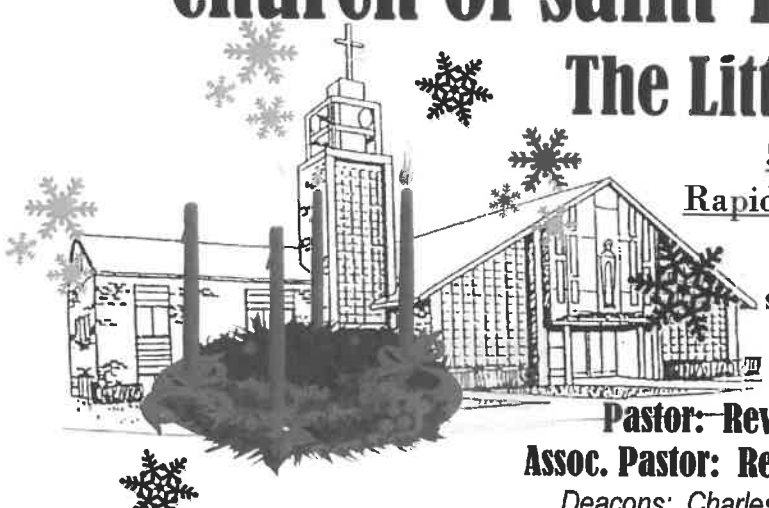

Immaculate Conception is one of the four dogmas of mother Mary for a Catholic to know. The four dogmas are: The motherhood of God, Perpetual virginity, Assumption and Immaculate Conception. By the word dogma we mean something of religious belief that people are expected to accept without any doubt.

The dogma of Immaculate Conception was defined by Pope Pius the 9th in 1854 and it is celebrated on 8th December every year. He defined that, Mary was preserved from the taint of original sin from the moment she was conceived. (Pope's encyclical *INEFFABILIS DEUS*).

To understand this in a simple way, in order to have clean water from the pipe, the pipe has to be clean first so, Mary can be compared to the pipe installed to carry clean water which is Jesus the Son of God! It was fitting for the mother who was to give birth to a son who was stainless to be stainless too.

In my tribe we have a saying, "Tell me your friend and I tell you who you are." Another saying goes, "Birds of the same feather flock together." Mary is our lovely mother, chosen by God our Father, and she was entrusted to us by Jesus on the cross with the very words of His, "Here is your mother!" Let us embrace her with love. Let us also strive to be pure like our mother.

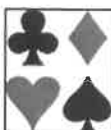

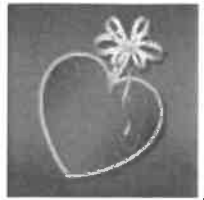

A letter from the Bishop...

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

During the weekend of December 10-11, our parishes will be conducting the **Retirement Fund for Religious Collection**, an annual appeal that benefits nearly 25,000 elderly sisters, brothers,

and religious order priests. Our senior religious are a treasure—both for their service to our church and for the ways their prayer and witness enrich our faith. "Planted in the house of the Lord, they shall flourish in the courts of our God. They shall bear fruit even in old age" (Ps 92:14-15).

As I reflect on the ministry of women and men religious—past and present—I am grateful for the ways they have shaped my own faith. I also value the tremendous service they have offered our diocese. Perhaps you, too, recall an older religious who made a positive difference in your life. Many in our diocese were formed, taught and nursed by the Benedictine Sisters of St. Martin Monastery and the religious men and women who faithfully served in parishes and missions in western South Dakota since the days when this was just a mission territory.

Most senior religious worked many years for little pay, leaving their religious communities with a shortage of retirement savings. Rising health-care costs and decreased income compound the challenge to meet day-to-day needs for medications, nursing assistance, and other necessities. Donations to the Retirement Fund for Religious provide financial support that helps religious communities care for aging members while ensuring younger ones can continue the good works of their elders.

I understand you are asked to support many worthy causes. I invite you to give what you can. Most importantly, please pray for God's continued blessing on all our women and men religious. Rest assured they are praying for you.
