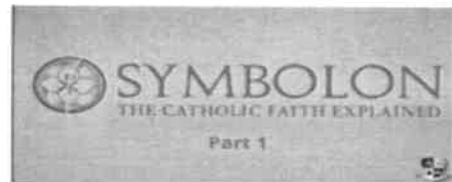

Dear friends,

Our security system is up and running. The ladies in the offices have become proficient with its use and appreciate the many different eyes that give them assistance with vigilance in the facility, and a small measure of security with people coming and going. It has excellent definition of images. We would not be able to afford the system without the most generous service of our parishioner Nick Semmler who gave at least six of his Saturdays donating installation of the hardware and wiring for the system. His able assistant Chad Carroll also worked on the project. Thank you, Nick, and Chad!

The finance and pastoral council each year prepare a list of needed maintenance projects, sometimes forecasting several years into the future. Even so, we get surprised by new needs. We have had our eyes on the aging heating and cooling system for several years. It is now time for a comprehensive study to find the best possible efficiencies for our building which was built in 1976 and added onto in 1991. The monthly or frequent donations you make to the building and maintenance fund are used for these projects. If you wish to make a designated gift, we will call it the HVAC Fund.

Next week I will be gone for retreat, Monday through Friday. While I am gone, please call the office during hours if you have an emergency, or call Cathedral. I was unable to find someone to cover our daily masses, so I encourage you to attend St. Isaac Jogues or the Cathedral. That reminds me, my frequent helper, and your former pastor Fr. Dan Juelfs will have the first of two, knee replacement surgeries this week. Please keep him in your prayers. Also pray for Fr. Mike Hight, native son of the parish for his continuing health struggles.

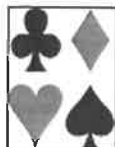

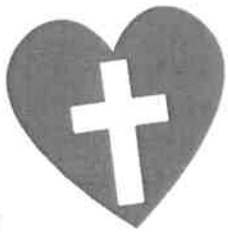
