An Update from the Hope For New Life (HFNL) Jail Ministry Sharen LaGrande's Story

Continuing with our ministry members' testimonials for joining HFNL, this is Sharen's story: "My journey to volunteer for HFNL started a few years ago. I received from my daughter a book by Matthew Kelly, *Rediscover Catholicism.* My children had been raised and baptized in the Catholic Church, but I never formally joined the church. Most of my adult life I worshiped in the Wesleyan Church. My daughter didn't realize when she gave me the book that I had felt an urging in my heart to return to the Catholic Church. After reading *Rediscover Catholicism,* I was certain that God was leading me back to the Catholic Church. Whenever I would visit my daughter and her family, I would go to Mass with them. Therefore, I wasn't totally uncomfortable when I decided to start attending Mass in Rapid City and completed the RCIA program.

One of the first changes in my new faith was the overwhelming realization that we are called to KNOW, LOVE and SERVE God. My faith was transformed from a selfish faith (just me and God against the world) to one which opened my heart to love and to serve my neighbor. Then I noticed a message in the bulletin about HFNL. I chose serving in the jail ministry because like me many of the inmates come from very broken backgrounds and have not had positive role models. I know what it is like to have made poor decisions in life and to have found the courage and strength to change my life's direction. I feel it is so important for the inmates to see God's love, grace and forgiveness in action. Thus they may form a love relationship with their Savior and receive the grace to change their lives."
