



Year of Faith - March 2013 "God's Work & Our

Work" - Sacramental Economy & Liturgy

The Sacramental Economy "is the communication (or 'dispensation') of the fruits of Christ's Paschal mystery in the celebration of the Church's 'sacramental' liturgy" (CCC 1076). 
