
# **Church of Saint Therese**

### == Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Friends,

Included in your bulletin today is the six month financial report for the parish. It shows we are at 50% of budgeted income for June through December, and are at 49% of expenses. We are doing well, therefore, and I am grateful for your sacrificial gift to St. Therese Church. The budget we prepared through the Finance Council and approved through the Parish Pastoral Council included a ten thousand dollar shortfall. In other words, we reached a bit with the hope that income, bequests, or gifts might come some time during the year. Your Finance Council monitors the budget monthly and makes sure we are not overspending, and are prepared for any emergencies.

Meanwhile we have received anonymous gifts from parishioners of siding for the north garage and LED lights for the facility totaling over seventy four hundred dollars. They followed up personal interest in these projects with generous gifts. Thank you!

In the bulletin you will see the figures for what we collect each week usually does not come up to the stated amount we need each week for our budget. Please know that some people give monthly, some give quarterly and others give yearly gifts. We had several end of the year collections around Christmas that made up lots of lost ground. Again, we are doing well thanks to your intentional and sacrificial aivina.
