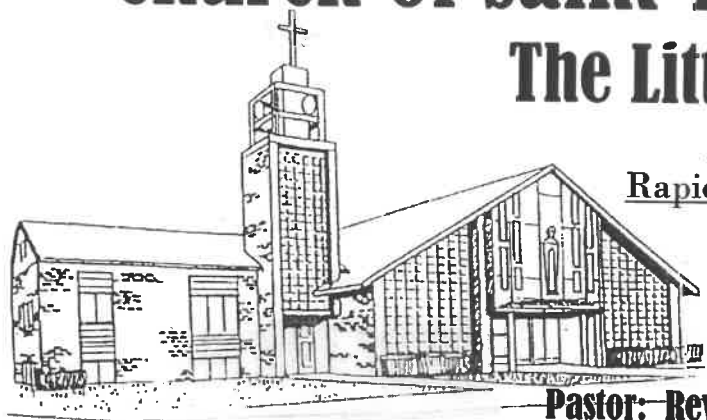

*Brothers and sisters:*

*If God is for us, who can be against us?*

*He who did not spare his own Son*

*how will he not also give us everything else along with him?*

Dear Friends,

We will begin vigil for the Mass of Christian Burial for Bishop Peter Muhich beginning Sunday at 1 p.m. The bulletin has details of various prayer services and times for you to come, view his body and pray for his soul. Like all Christians, Bishop Peter asks that he be prayed for in death, for the acceptance of his life and suffering to increase the Eucharistic Revival in our Diocese and that God may have mercy on his soul.

I am glad the Church chose this reading from St. Paul's Letter to the Romans, above, on the vigil of his funeral. Paul reminds us that nothing can dim the light of hope that Christ places in our hearts of victory over death and our participation in the glorious resurrection. From the beginning of his diagnosis with esophageal cancer, to the news at various stages of his treatment, to the discomforts of swallowing, to the impossibility of swallowing and the use of his feeding tube, Bishop Peter was prayerful, courageous, and serene. He placed his trust in Our Lady of Perpetual Help and Our Lady of the Rosary.

He came to rely upon his friends, staff, and his priests during his treatment, only asking for our patience and prayers. Liturgically, we will no longer remember him in the Eucharistic Prayer, but we will all hopefully remember "our Bishop Peter" for a long time.

Please pray especially for his parents, Louis and Sally. They were too frail to attend his consecration as bishop, nor can they come for his funeral. Pray for safe travel for all who are attending.

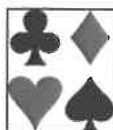
