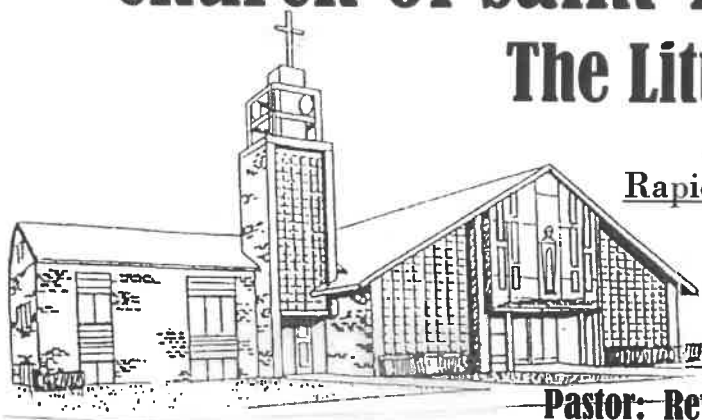

== *Fr. Kerry's Korner* ==

Dear Lenten Pilgrims,

We have begun the discipline of Lent with the imposition of ashes last Wednesday. Of course, weather kept many away from the services, but not from the desire to make a return to the Lord. This Lent we are in the midst of the National Eucharistic Revival. The end result of the revival is to make missionary disciples with a love and understanding of the Eucharist in daily living. Because Lent has the three pillars of prayer, fasting and almsgiving, we can choose from many activities and directions.

In prayer, I recommend the weekly **Stations of the Cross** devotion scheduled in both our parishes. Please see the bulletin. Also **adoration**, praying before the exposed Eucharist, Friday 8 a.m. at St. Therese, and 24/7 every day at the Mother Church, Cathedral of Our Lady of Perpetual Help. I reserve a time each Thursday to offer an hour to the Lord at the Cathedral. If you feel called to join the prayer and ministry of Perpetual Adoration, go to <https://www.cathedralolph.org/perpetual-adoration.html> and sign in as a guest to Adoration Pro. You will need some assistance setting up a permanent time if you choose after 10 p.m. and before 6 a.m. They will give you a fob for access to the adoration chapel. You may always stop by for a visit when you are in town.

Almsgiving is the practice of helping the poor and comforting the afflicted. We begin Ash Wednesday with the annual collection to assist Catholic Social Services, CSS. If you missed this year, give a specially marked check or envelope or go to the CSS website. Black and Indian Mission collection of the American bishops is next week, and the big event, Catholic Relief Services is in March. CRS is our response to disasters, wars, famine, and disease throughout the world. It is very worthy to sacrifice for this organization.

For **spiritual growth and prayer** I highly encourage attending the sessions of No Greater Love scheduled at St. Therese. To grow in our eucharistic identity and faith, I urge you all to go to the National Eucharistic Revival website and get on their email list for reflections and articles promoting the revival. Each meditation has been helpful. Go to www.eucharisticrevival.org/get-involved and scroll to the bottom of the page to receive the email weekly for great content. There is much to explore this Lent and always from this sight.

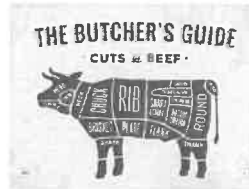

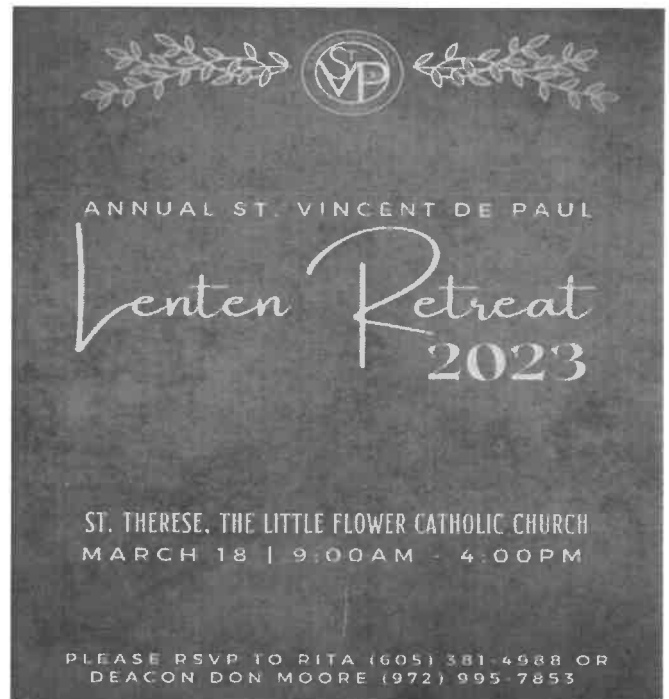
