== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Parish Family,

This Wednesday we begin the season of Lent taking upon ourselves the sign of ashes and renewing our prayer that, as we pray on Ash Wednesday, "we may begin this campaign of Christian service, . . . as we take up battle against spiritual evils, and be armed with self-restraint." In the bulletin, you will find a section entitled Lenten Campaign of Renewal which will list the many opportunities for prayer, retreat, service, and learning that are available in Rapid City, our parishes, and online.

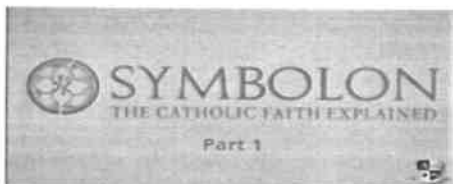
I especially urge you to attempt going to daily Mass at the various parishes, put the Stations of the Cross and the Friday soup suppers on your calendar, and be attentive to the opportunities to give alms through the various National Collections in Lent.

Our Holy Father, Francis, particularly asks that this coming Wednesday, March 2, be an International Day of Prayer For Peace to turn away the invading forces of war in Ukraine and elsewhere. In his annual message to the Church Francis writes, *Christ's resurrection enlivens earthly hopes with the "great hope" of eternal life, planting the seed of salvation in our present time (cf. BENEDICT XVI, Spe Salvi, 3; 7). Bitter disappointment at shattered dreams, deep concern for the challenges ahead and discouragement at the poverty of our resources, can make us tempted to seek refuge in self-centeredness and indifference to the suffering of others. Indeed, even our best resources have their limitations: "Youths grow tired and weary, the young stumble and fall" (Is 40:30). Yet God "gives strength to the weary, he strengthens the powerless... Those who hope in the Lord will regain their strength, they will soar on wings like eagles; though they run they will not grow weary, though they walk they will never tire. (Is 40:29, 31).*

In charitable response to the needs of the world's poor and the refugees of war, I particularly ask that every table or home altar, in every dwelling in our parish, involving the young and the old who reside there, have a Rice Bowl from Catholic Relief Services to receive the alms made available by our sacrifices.

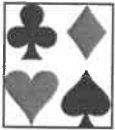

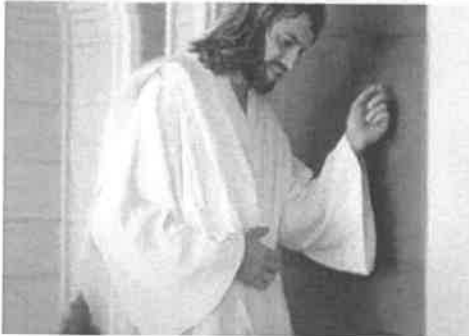
