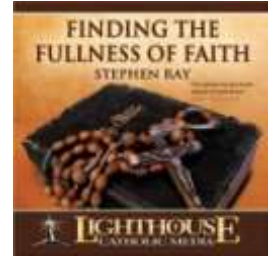
ANOTHER WEEKLY FUNNY...from Father Bill

RCCSS Packing Hope and STM HS Poverty Retreat

The Rapid City Catholic School System is in the midst of its 6th annual Packing Hope campaign. This is when we come together as a school system to buy, pack, and ship food to orphanages, malnutrition centers, and remote villages in Honduras. Last year, with the help of the Church parishes, we raised over \$15,000 and packed close to 100,000 meals. We hope to surpass that this year and pack 150,000 meals on Feb. 22nd! We are excited to be adding to our day a Poverty Simulation, for grades 9-12, led by Barbara Garcia from the Rapid City Community Development Agency. The simulation is a tool that educates students about the day to day realities of life with a shortage of money and an abundance of stress. It is our hope that the day will help us to develop a greater level of compassion, empathy, and appreciation.
