== *Fr. Kerry's Korner* ==

Dear Friends,

Sunday last, I preached about the need to remain close to Christ, close to the Sacraments, and close to the needy as the sure way to continue growing in holiness. Especially the last, remaining accessible to the needy, is an important part of being in Christ. Jesus makes our relationship with us personal. In prayer, we draw near to the person of Jesus, and we receive his love. Jesus also comes to all personally. He went to Peter's mother-in-law, grasped her hand, healed her fever, and helped her up. Could he have snapped his fingers from the other side of the room? I don't think that was the Lord at all.

The Lord will always enter a relationship with us. In the words of Pope Benedict XVI in his inaugural homily, "We are not some casual and meaningless product of evolution. Each of us is the result of a thought of God. Each of us is willed, each of us is loved, each of us is necessary. There is nothing more beautiful than to be surprised by the Gospel, by the encounter with Christ. There is nothing more beautiful than to know Him and to speak to others of our friendship with Him." May God reward your effort to pray daily and serve Him in his needy brothers and sisters.

This week Fr. Andrzej let us know that his CT scan showed that he is doing well and will see his doctor in another six months. He asks us to continue prayers for him and Bishop Peter through intercession to Servant of God Nicholas Black Elk. Bishop Peter has also announced that he received a feeding tube last week which he calls "a good thing" so he can continue his treatment. Praise God that he continues to heal our brothers and bless our diocese. I am reminded of Psalm 147.3-4: *He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds. He tells the number of the stars; he calls each by name.*

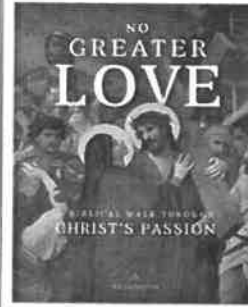

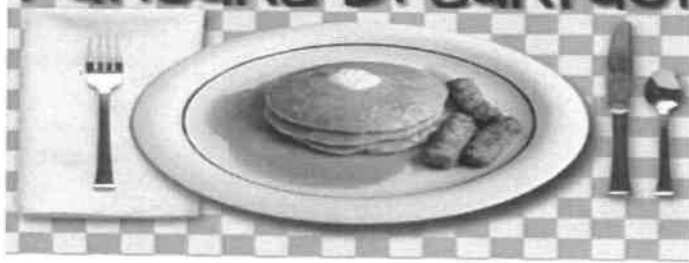
