



## Update on Italy ~ Day 6 ~ June 13, 2017

Rome - Roman Basilicas, Relics of Jerusalem Today we start the day with a visit to Our Lady of Victory, dedicated to the Virgin Mary and known for the Ecstasy of Saint Teresa sculpture by Bernini. We also see the Church of Santa Susanna, which is the American Church in Rome. Passing the nearby Piazza delia Republica we go to St. Mary Major where we celebrate Mass, St. John the Lateran, the cathedral Church of Rome containing sacred relics of Peter and Paul and the magnificent sculptures of the twelve apostles.
