== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Friends,

We, each of us, have a relationship with the sacred Word of God. We sometimes hear descriptions of the Word that we may resonate with and some portrayals of what sacred scripture is that don't match our experience. St. Paul assures us that the word of God is living and effective, sharper than a two-edged sword. Sometimes the word of God captures us with its simplicity, incisiveness, boldness, or its subtlety. Occasionally we are mystified by sayings that are bound up in another culture or the wisdom of another tribe.

The scriptures this week are simple, direct, compelling, and beautiful. They remind us we are all related. When we heal the sorrow of a poor man, we heal ourselves. When the just man is mistreated, we all suffer. *"If you bestow your bread on the hungry and satisfy the afflicted; then light shall rise for you in the darkness, and the gloom shall become for you like midday."* (Isaiah 58:10) Why is our world in so much hurt? We simply do not recognize that every suffering is our suffering. We fail to cast light in the darkness.

I heard a beautiful speech by an actress in a movie that felt like she was quoting a saga. It was this prescient, anonymous Greek proverb: *Society grows great when old men plant trees whose shade they know they shall never sit in.* It is what good people do. We are changed by faith in the potentiality of the future we may never experience. We are changed by a thought, a prayer, a fine deed.

You are the salt of the earth!

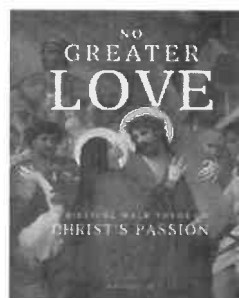

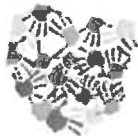


