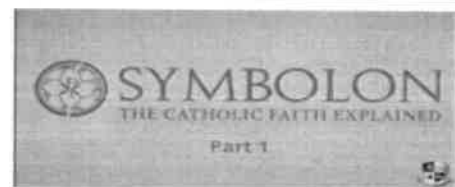

== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear friends,

Wednesday last, we remembered the Feast of the Presentation of our Lord in the temple. Jesus being



presented with an offering of two doves to redeem him according to the law was seen as the fulfillment of the words of the

Prophet Malachi, "Thus says the Lord GOD: Lo, I am sending my messenger to prepare the way before me; and suddenly there will come to the temple the Lord whom you seek, and the messenger of the covenant whom you desire." Mal.3.1

In the gospel account, the holy family is met by Simeon and Anna, both elderly and faithful. They were habitués of the temple, constantly in prayer and contemplation. They were ready to recognize the Messiah when he came (suddenly). Without this life of contemplative prayer, they would not have recognized an infant as the child of the Promise. Nor could they know that he would be the cause of the rise and fall of many in Israel, or that Mary's heart would be pierced with Sorrow. They exemplify the need and the harvest of contemplative prayer.

In 1997 Pope John Paul II named the Feast of the Presentation as the Worldwide Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life. The religious sisters, brothers, priests, consecrated virgins, and nuns are examples of lives dedicated to complete prayer and work. Today as I write on this Feast, I remember with gratitude the School Sisters of Notre Dame who educated me in High School and who helped call forth my vocation. The various religious orders that currently serve in our diocese, and those who spent their life and their patrimony for the Diocese of Rapid City, I honor and express my gratitude.

On the day Pope St. John Paul II established this commemoration of Consecrated life he wrote: *Truly there is great urgency that the consecrated life show itself ever more "full of joy and of the Holy Spirit," that it forge ahead dynamically in the paths of mission, that it be backed up by the strength of lived witness, because "modern man listens more willingly to witnesses than to teachers, and if he does listen to teachers, it is because they are witnesses"* (Apostolic Exhortation, *Evangelii Nuntiandi* 41).

Let us be witnesses after the manner of the witnesses we have been blessed to know.

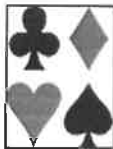
