## == Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Friends,

For the last two weeks we have had Blane Schriock, a seminarian for our diocese from Watauga, living at the rectory and learning more about the diocese by interviewing chancery personnel and priests. This is part of their J term at St. Paul Seminary. He leaves this Sunday to go to the March for Life in Washington DC. It was good having him here and getting to know him a bit more. His mother, Amy, was a young girl when I was a pastor at Watauga in the late 80's. After this school year he will have about three more years of formation before ordination.

The time in seminary is for growth in prayer and theological understanding, and deepening the trust we have in God's call for us. This past Wednesday we read the story of the call of Samuel to be a prophet: *The LORD called Samuel again, for the third time. Getting up and going to Eli, he said, "Here I am. You called me." Then Eli understood that the LORD was calling the youth. So, Eli said to Samuel, "Go to sleep, and if you are called, reply, 'Speak, LORD, for your servant is listening.'" When Samuel went to sleep in his place, the LORD came and revealed his presence, calling out as before, "Samuel, Samuel!" Samuel answered, "Speak, for your servant is listening."* 1 Samuel 3.8-10

The seminarian we were supporting, Treyton Bushong, has prayerfully discerned that the Lord is not calling him to be a priest at this time. He has discontinued seminary study. The parish will begin sending a gift each month to help with expenses to another seminarian, Liam Pelayic. Liam is in his first year of college and second year of formation. He is studying at Immaculate Heart of Mary seminary in Winona, Minnesota. His family are members of the Cathedral parish.

In addition to writing a letter and sending a gift to one seminarian each month, we make a yearly gift of \$12,000 from St. Therese and from St. John's of \$1,000 for the Seminarian Fund, which helps the Diocese pay for seminary education and formation of our future priests. Thank you for your help in reaching our yearly goal.
