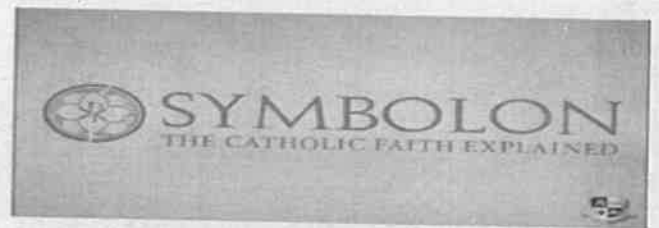

Dear parish family,

The Diocese of Rapid City has been planning for the last year for a strategic planning process that would help us use our resources in the diocese to the best of our ability and set the diocese in the best possible position to maximize our gifts for the sake of renewal and growth of the Catholic Church. The planning process has to take into account the population shifts, growth projections, stability of our current parish configurations, priest resources now and in the next 5-10 years, and more.

While the Presbyteral Council (priests) have set some goals and values for the plan, we now want the faithful to weigh in with your comments and observations of these goals and values, and to surface values and goals from your perspective. We will do this with town hall sessions in the parishes all over the diocese.

The Town Hall will begin with a presentation by Fr. Kerry and then open to a comment, and question and answer period. Strategic planning is not about closing parishes. It will be about assessing our strengths and determining what we might do to share resources to better parish life.

If you were unable to attend the Town Hall meeting on the 11th, we will host another one Saturday, January 22nd at 5:30 pm in the Parish Hall. I hope many of you can attend!

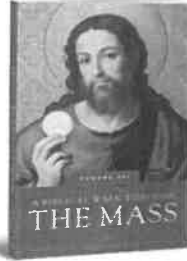

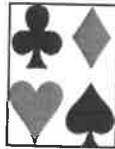
