== *Fr. Kerry's Korner* ==

Dear Friends,

People are very fond of labels. Labels that inform, give origin, health information, ingredients, expiration date. These labels inform from the general to the very particular. Labels can also be used to name or generalize people, under one label, according to what they say or believe. So catchwords become identifiers, simplifiers, to quickly group, and often dismiss, people or ideas. The most familiar examples may be those that help us identify liberals or conservatives. If you said this conservative Senator is valued for liberality of his ideas, or that liberal governor was conservative in implementation of his policies, you would be accused of dealing in oxymoron. Labels don't always help.

Paul begins his first letter to the people of Corinth addressing the problems of division among them. I am one of Paul's Christians. I belong to Apollos (another preacher). This rang false in Paul's ears. Is Christ to be divided? Rather Paul would remind them that they were all baptized into Christ's death that they may rise with him, saying, "For Christ did not send me to baptize but to preach the gospel, and not with the wisdom of human eloquence, so that the cross of Christ might not be emptied of its meaning." 1 Cor. 1.17

The power of Christ shines forth in the weak. Witness is more powerful than word. In a time where words can be used to divide, "I am a Pope Benedict Catholic," "I am a Pope Francis Catholic," our witness will be the way we create unity out of division. And our witness must come from our love of the Master, Jesus Christ. He is the source of our witness and unity. The oneness of three persons in one God is a witness of communion and love.

This Sunday is the Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection for Unborn Children and this week is the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. In our prayers, words, witness and hopes, let us remember that all human life is sacred, and the way we use our words will bear witness to the Logos, The Word that became flesh and dwelt among us.

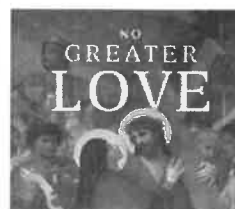
