Dear Friends,

Last Monday throughout the United States, the Church commemorated the Day of Prayer for the protection of the unborn. This Sunday, the Rapid City Right to Life group will feature a time of prayer and a speaker for the unborn. With the recent March on Washington, we were able to see the energy of our young Church in the defense of human life. Young people in parishes I have served, Katie French from St. Therese, and many others were featured in news clips and social media advocating for the unborn. Our president made an appearance in support of life in the womb also.

I am pleased to see so many of our parishioners active in the defense and promotion of human life. We have many volunteers in Love, Inc., Catholic Social Services, Habitat for Humanity, Mommy's Closet, Birthright, prison ministry, home communion visitors, Knights of Columbus, meals at the Shelter, caregivers for the elderly in nursing homes, and many more ministries. One of the greatest ways we serve the human family is bringing God's love and dignity to someone who is on the ropes. It is a principle of social justice called solidarity which impels us to take the part of the defenseless or voiceless.

A group of Catholics from the city and beyond used to pray every Friday at the Federal Building at 9th and Main for religious liberty. We experienced great support, benign indifference and the occasional coarse and hateful invective. Last week I saw a small group of people protesting peacefully at the corner of 5th and Omaha. A large diesel pickup stopped, opening their windows to film the event and then poured on the fuel to cover them in black soot and scorn. Of course we cannot rob someone of their human dignity unless they let us, but we should always show respect and civility in our disagreements. Let us always do the truth in love.


